Tasting Notes

A beautiful dark ruby color and a wonderful spicy aromas fill the senses. A lovely mid pallet of subtle blackberry with an extracted finish. An intense wine that needs proper aging to benefit from the rustic flavors of its Italian origin. A dinner wine that will only improve with age.

Wine Maker

This is the oldest known grape vineyard in America. Legend has it that Mark Twain wrote his first book in this vineyard as a cub reporter for the Sacramento Union newspaper. The vines came from the Jackio Blanco vineyard in Alba in Italy and found a home in the foothills of California. I loved the wine so much, I bought the vineyard and founded my first winery there, Renwood. I traditional bottle age the wine for 5 years as is the tradition in Alba, after aging the wine in oak for two years. The wine like a few hours of air before it is ready to drink. This is the only Italian origin Nebbiolo in America. Produced exclusively by Cabana Winery Ciao !
