Varietal	Petite Sirah  Double Gold, American wine Society.
Tasting Notes	<p>A big bold wine, ripe in flavors of blackberries, coffee, and dark chocolate. A full-bodied wine, with nice acid and big tannins make this a "plush" feel on your palate. Lovely aromas of all spice and black pepper waft through the wine. The dark berry and big oak flavors leave your mouth full of flavor, with a smooth finish.</p> <p>Pairs well with BBQ, Mexican food, grilled meats and spicy bold cooking.</p>
Wine Maker	<p>The 2017 vintage was lush, and well balanced. The grapes were picked at 24 brix. Fermented in small lots over 10 days. Barrel aged for 24 months to tame the wine. The wine was filtered at bottling to ensure smooth drinking. Bottled aged for 2 years.</p>
