

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Tasting Notes: On the palate, this wine opens with bright tones of grapefruit, nectarine, and notes of lychee. A clean, crisp wine with a rich, textured finish.

CHARDONNAY

Tasting Notes: Opulent, ripe fruit flavors of honey melon, papaya, and a hint of citrus coat your palate. Relish the delicate aromas of honey and lemon zest to create depth and balance throughout. Subtle tones of caramel and a hint of butter round out the long finish.

PINOT NOIR

Tasting Notes: This Pinot is firm with acidity and tannins, imparting structure and definition. Exhibits an elegant, fruity character, rich in mineral aromas and flavors of wild strawberries, pomegranate, and black currant.



Tasting Notes: A dark, rich wine aged in French oak delivers flavors of black cherries and mocha. The layers of ripe fruit and tannins give your mouth a rich, lush feel. This balanced wine offers a velvet, smooth finish. PETIT SIRAH

Tasting Notes: This wine is saturated with blackberry, blueberry, and plum, with notes of cocoa and black pepper. On the palate, the generous blackberry and peppery plum flavors linger with delicate hints of anise seed, clove, and cedar spice from the oak ageing. This wine is smooth and silky with velvety tannins and a generous lengthy finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Tasting Notes: A beautiful, dark ruby color and lavish, spicy aromas fill the senses. A lovely mid-pallet of lush blackberry with oak and tannin. This well-balanced wine delivers a smooth finish, with hints of dark chocolate.

OLD VINE ZINFANDEL

Tasting Notes: This bold wine works spicy, complex, oak flavors into its

potent blackberry and dark chocolate base, while firm tannins add to its structure and grippy mouth feel. It's assertive and dry, for drinkers who like a little bite in their wine.



Cabana Wineries flagship wine is RISK Cabernet from Oakville in Napa. RISK (Robert, Irene, Sarah & Kelly) is the pinnacle of Robert Smerling's 30 years as a winemaker, winning numerous double gold medals.

OAKVILLE- CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Tasting Notes: This Oakville, Napa Valley wine is a classic Bordeaux blend, hand-picked from the vines. Fermented in small lots and aged in new French oak barrels for 18 months, this wine has concentrated layers of blackberry, dark chocolate, and hints of cedar. The polished tannin will make this a great wine to cellar for the next decade. 110 cases produced.

AMADOR COUNTY- NEBBIOLO

Tasting Notes: This earthy wine is the sister wine to our Barbera, originating from the same Shenandoah Valley region of Amador County. A beautiful ruby color, this rustic wine is reminiscent of the great Barolo's and Barbaresco's of Italy. Wonderful spicy aromas fill the senses, while robust tannins and flavors of dark cherry and cranberry coat the palate. Limited production of 60 cases.

AMADOR COUNTY- BARBERA

Tasting Notes: Returning to his Amador roots from his Renwood days, Robert captures the essence of the Italian Piedmont region with this well-balanced

Barbera. Packed with fruit flavor, this full-bodied wine feels comfortable on the palate and exhibits abundant ripe blackberry, fig, and plum flavors. Just the right amount of dark fruit with hints of acid, aged in oak for 9 months. Limited production of 120 cases.
