Tasting Notes

On the first sip your mouth fills with dark jammy fruit. This 105-year-old head trained vineyard produces intense flavors. Lots of blackberries and dark chocolate, mixed with aromas of cedar and spice. Hint of oak melds with the rich fruit and black pepper. A big wine with a smooth finish.

Wine Maker

Pairs well with BBQ, Burgers, pizza and spicy cooking.

Our 2020 is a stellar example of why Lodi can make incredible wines. Picked at 24. To 26 brix. The grapes cold soaked for 3 days, before a 10-day fermentation. The wine was aged in American Oak barrels for 16 months, which keeps the wine fresh on the pallet. Filtered and bottled, ready to drink.
