The Fire Marshal shall prohibit open burning that will be offensive or objectionable due to smoke or odor emissions when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fire hazardous. The Fire Marshal shall order the extinguishments, by the permit holder, of any open burning when the wind speed is 10 miles per hour or higher and when the humidity is 50 percent or lower, or when the burning creates or adds to a hazardous or objectionable situation. All burning operations shall be from the hours of 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. All open burns shall be at least 500 feet from any structure. ACD operations must take place at least 200 feet from any structure. Open burns shall not be utilized for any of the following materials: household trash, rubber, tires, shingles, vinyl siding, treated lumber and leaves. The burning season shall exist from September 16 through April 14 of each year.

This permit should not be construed to allow open burning that causes or constitutes a public health hazard, nuisance, or a hazard to vehicular or air traffic or violates any other rule or statute.

Details regarding the above requested must be filed when application is made and whenever requested by the Fire Marshal. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that conditions are in accordance with applicable State and Local fire regulations.
