MaBSTOA Dispatcher Exam Filing Deadline Extended. By: Daniel "Danny" Cruz

The deadline to file for the MaBSTOA Dispatcher Exam (No. 3208) has been extended to October 14th, 2022. While this is good news for many, the Transit Authority took the liberty to expand the eligibility criteria to those in the Transit Support Coordinator title as well, infringing on the sole promotional pathway for MaBSTOA Bus Operators'. The violation was discovered by Flatbush Depot Chairman, Richard Thorne and TWU Union-Wide Executive - Recording Secretary, LaTonya Crisp which resulted in MaBSTOA Vice-President, Donald Yates filing a grievance to protect the only and long standing promotional pathway for MaBSTOA Bus Operators' - the grievance is pending a resolution.

Due to language in NYS Public Authorities Law, MaBSTOA Bus Operators' are not awarded Civil Service status and are not afforded the same Promotional and Restricted Duty pathways as TA Bus Operators'. The Protection of MaBSTOA practices are paramount.

MTA Violated Bronx Bus Operators' Run Pay Practices.

When a new run or work schedule is prepared, the Chairman of each depot is given a period of time to review the prints and voice any concerns, if none are vocalized, the pick goes on as usual.

When newly elected Gun Hill Chairman, Tom Browne received the Fall 2022 run prints a thorough audit of the proposed work schedules revealed that the MTA had not been paying any headway allowance to Bus Operators' on both the Local and Select Bx41 (Bus Operators' are entitled to headway allowance on top of their run pay whenever the printed work requires them to travel back to the depot from a relief point) - a practice that robbed Bus Operators' of at least 40 hours of additional pay in a year.

Thanks to Mr. Browne's swift action, the headway allowance pay was restored to the Local and Select Bx41 schedules as of the start of the Fall 2022 pick.

Appointed Union Positions - An Erosion of Union Democracy?


