Transit Workers Who Helped Riders to Safety Honored.

For transit workers' - day in and day out, no two days are alike and Tuesday, April 12th, 2022 proved this saying to be true when an active shooter situation unfolded at the 36th Street subway station in Brooklyn. On Friday, April 15th, 2022, the NYC Mayor's office honored 5 transit workers who showed up and showed out to bring New Yorkers to safety - keeping their cool amid the chaos. One of those 5 transit workers was Jackie Gleason Depot's very own, Parla Mejia, who while operating the B37 route evacuated many from the dangerous scene.

Violent crime within the NYC transit system has skyrocketed, according to NYPD statistics there has been a 68% increase in major felonies within the system. If the riders aren't safe - neither are we.

Bronx Redesign Pick Sparks Questionable Arbitration Decision. By: Michael Enriquez

The Bronx Bus Network Redesign is set to go into effect on Sunday, June 26th, 2022. In Mid-April, Arbitrator Edelman rendered a non-precedental decision regarding the Bus Operators' summer pick - ruling that there shall be a MaBSTOA-wide general pick, excluding the TA Surface division from participating (TA Surface will have a summer in-house depot pick). In the decision, the Arbitrator wrote, "...the changes are significant and restricting the pick within each of the depots does not adequately take into account the seniority rights of all affected employees." but, what about the seniority rights of the OA members who work in TA Surface? A full General Pick would have had no effect on the protected OA pick practices. OA members currently make up 39% of the TA Surface division and are excluded from exercising their seniority rights this coming pick.
