#### TNPHC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION LETTER

The Tallahassee National Pan-Hellenic Council (TNPHC) is currently composed of nine (9) International Greek letter Sororities and Fraternities: Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.; Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.; Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.; Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.; Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.; Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.; Zeta Phi Beta Fraternity, Inc.; Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.; and Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc. TNPHC promotes interaction through forums, meetings, Initiatives and Service Projects through various activities and functions.

The stated purpose and mission of the organization in 1930 was "Unanimity of thought and action as far as possible in the conduct of Greek letter collegiate fraternities and sororities, and considering problems of mutual interest to its member organizations."

One of the collective mutual interests of the TNPHC is the pursuit of higher education among students in the greater Tallahassee area. TNPHC will recognize and honor students who are committed to academic excellence, positive leadership and community service by awarding **\$1,000.00** in scholarships. \$500 worth of scholarship money will be available to FAMU students and \$500 worth of scholarship money to FSU students respectively. Only members of any of the National Pan-Hellenic Greek organizations that are currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at FAMU or FSU are eligible.

Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of scholastic achievement, community service, a cover letter, resume and two references. Applicants must possess a minimum grade point average of 2.5 for undergraduate on a 4.00 scale. All applicants must have the recommendation of their respective collegiate advisor / advisory team.

### **Undergraduate Eligibility Requirements and Application Guidelines**

- 1. Applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at FAMU or FSU.
- 2. Must be a <u>financial member</u> of a National Pan-Hellenic Greek Organization during the 2020-2021 academic school year.
- 3. The applicant must have earned an overall grade point average (GPA) of **2.5** on a 4.00 scale.
- 4. The complete Scholarship Application packet must be postmarked by **November 13**, **2023**.
- 5. Collegiate advisors / advisory team must submit a Scholarship Application on behalf of the applicant. The Scholarship application should evoke the community service, academic performance and/or achievement in field of study of the applicant. Scholarship Application must be typed, 12 point, Times Roman and a maximum of 200 words.

#### The following must be returned to TNPHC in one packet:

- ✓ Completed and signed application
- ✓ Scholarship Application from Collegiate Advisor / Advisory Team (Must be typed, double spaced, 12 point, Times Roman)
- ✓ Official transcript provided in a University sealed and stamped envelope
- ✓ Incomplete and handwritten applications WILL NOT be considered.
