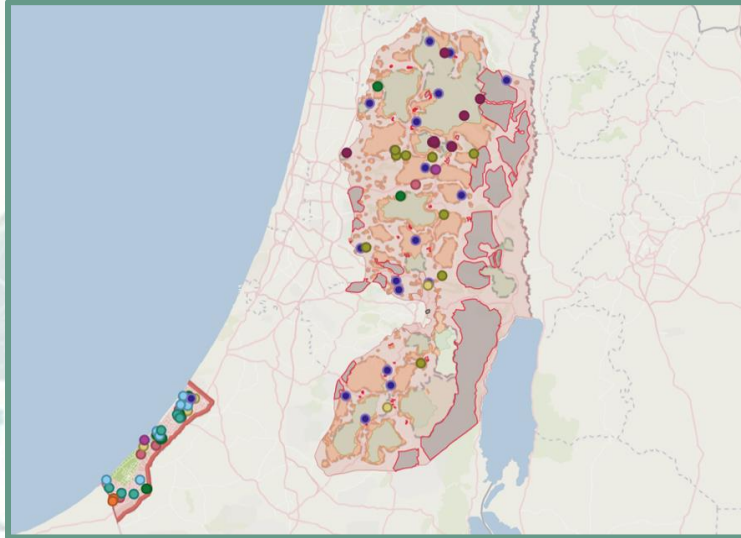




Daily Security Update: Occupied Palestine

Reporting Period: 5th – 6th January 2025



KEY POLITICAL DEVELOPMENTS

- Hamas released footage of IDF hostage Liri Elbag, renewing public and family pressure on the Israeli government to prioritize hostage recovery. Negotiations, mediated by Qatar and Egypt, are ongoing in Doha, with Hamas approving a list of 34 hostages for exchange. However, progress remains tied to Hamas demands for Israeli withdrawal from Gaza and a ceasefire.
- Mossad Director David Barnea is set to meet officials in Doha to finalize the terms of a deal. The U.S. continues to push for a ceasefire and humanitarian aid flow.
- The humanitarian crisis deepens as Israeli airstrikes killed nine humanitarian convoy personnel in Gaza, including four in Deir al-Balah. Gaza's death toll has surpassed 45,800, with over 109,000 injured, as reported by the Hamas-controlled Health Ministry.
- All northern Gaza hospitals are now non-operational, and the UN has criticized IDF actions, including alleged violations of international law during the Kamal Adwan Hospital raid.
- The U.S. announced an \$8 billion arms package for Israel, including artillery shells, bombs, and missile guidance systems, though delivery timelines may extend for years.
- Reports revealed that President Biden's October visit was instrumental in restarting humanitarian aid to Gaza. President-elect Trump's appointments of pro-Israel figures Tammy Bruce and Morgan Ortagus to State Department roles signal continued U.S. support for Israel.
- Violence escalates with IDF operations in Nablus and Meithalun resulting in the deaths of two Palestinians, whose body was removed by Israeli forces.
- In Silwad, settlers attacked Palestinian farmers, injuring seven, while IDF troops on-site did not intervene. Separately, a Palestinian woman's attempted stabbing in Deir Qaddis prompted increased Israeli security restrictions.

KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS

Occupied West Bank

Nablus Governorate

Over this reporting period, five notable incidents were reported in the **Nablus Governorate** involving **Israeli Armed Forces**, **Non-State Armed Actors**, and **Israeli settlers**. These incidents reflect a volatile security environment marked by search operations, armed clashes, settler attacks, and a criminal investigation. The main areas of focus included **Nablus Old City**, **Khallet Al Amoud**, **Balata Refugee Camp**, and **Burin village**. Clashes between Israeli Armed Forces and Non-State Armed Actors were recurring, with notable confrontations in **Nablus Old City**, **Khallet Al Amoud**, and **Balata Refugee Camp**, resulting in injuries and structural damage. Additionally, a criminal investigation into the discovery of a Palestinian woman's body in Nablus City has added to the complexity of the security situation. An attack on Palestinian vehicles by Israeli settlers in **Burin village** further heightened tensions, reflecting ongoing inter-community frictions.

- **05/01/2025, 02:30hrsLT | Nablus Old City:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation. Clashes erupted between Non-State Armed Actors and Israeli Armed Forces, with an exchange of fire leading to three injuries. No arrests were reported.
- **05/01/2025, 17:00hrsLT | Khallet Al Amoud, Nablus City:** Clashes broke out during a search operation by Israeli Armed Forces. A Palestinian was injured by a live bullet. No arrests were made.
- **05/01/2025, 19:30hrsLT | Nablus City:** The body of a Palestinian woman was discovered. Palestinian Armed Forces initiated an investigation, suspecting a criminal motive.
- **06/01/2025, 00:15hrsLT | Balata Refugee Camp:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation. Clashes ensued between Non-State Armed Actors and Israeli Armed Forces, with reports of pipe bombs being thrown. No injuries or arrests were reported, but significant infrastructure damage was observed.
- **06/01/2025, 10:15hrsLT | Burin:** Israeli settlers reportedly attacked Palestinian vehicles in Burin village, south of Nablus. No injuries were reported.

Tulkarm Governorate

Two incidents were reported in the Tulkarm Governorate over the past 24 hours, involving both **Israeli Armed Forces** and **Palestinian Armed Forces**. The incidents occurred in the **Iktaba neighbourhood** of Tulkarm City and **Atil village**, reflecting ongoing tensions.

- **05/01/2025, 04:30hrsLT | Iktaba:** A search operation was conducted by Israeli Armed Forces in the Iktaba neighbourhood of Tulkarm City. No arrests were reported, indicating a low-intensity operation targeting potential security threats.
- **06/01/2025, 23:45hrsLT | Atil:** Palestinian Armed Forces shot, injured, and arrested two civilians in Atil village, north of Tulkarm. This indicates heightened enforcement actions targeting individuals suspected of militancy or affiliation with Non-State Armed Actors.



Jenin Governorate

Over the past 24 hours, seven incidents were reported in the **Jenin Governorate** involving **Israeli Armed Forces, Palestinian Armed Forces, and Non-State Armed Actors**. These incidents involved search and arrest operations, armed clashes, and significant civilian impacts, particularly in **Meithalun, Jenin City, and Al-Yamun**.

The incidents were characterized using live ammunition, tear gas, and heavy weaponry, creating heightened risks for both civilians and infrastructure. Key hotspots included the **Jenin Refugee Camp** and **Al-Yamun**, where repeated clashes and military operations were reported. A notable escalation involved the seizure of an RPG weapon by Non-State Armed Actors, reflecting an increased level of armament and a potential for intensified clashes.

- **05/01/2025, 07:00hrsLT | Meithalun:** Israeli Armed Forces shot, killed, and arrested a civilian during a search operation in Meithalun village.
- **05/01/2025, 12:00hrsLT | Jenin Refugee Camp:** Armed clashes occurred between Non-State Armed Actors and Palestinian Armed Forces near the entrance of Jenin Refugee Camp. Tear gas injuries were reported, and Non-State Armed Actors seized an RPG weapon.
- **06/01/2025, 04:00hrsLT | Al-Yamun:** Israeli Armed Forces arrested three civilians during a search operation in Al-Yamun village.
- **06/01/2025, 13:00hrsLT | Jenin Refugee Camp:** Armed clashes resumed near the Jenin Refugee Camp, leading to additional tear gas injuries and the arrest of one civilian.

Hebron Governorate

During this period, four incidents were reported in the **Hebron Governorate**, involving search operations and civilian arrests by **Israeli Armed Forces**. These incidents occurred in **Halhul, Dura, Hebron City, Hebron Old City, and Idhna**, highlighting ongoing Israeli security measures in both urban and rural areas.

The incidents reflect a sustained focus on search operations targeting suspected individuals, as well as civilian impacts, including arrests and an assault. The highest concentration of activity occurred in **Hebron City**, specifically in the **Jabal Abu Rumman** area and the **H2 area of the Old City**, where multiple arrests were reported.

- **05/01/2025, 17:45hrsLT | Halhul:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation in Halhul village, north of Hebron. No arrests were reported.
- **05/01/2025, 20:01hrsLT | Dura:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation in Dura town, south of Hebron. No arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 01:15hrsLT | Hebron City:** A civilian was assaulted and arrested by Israeli Armed Forces during a search operation in the Jabal Abu Rumman area of Hebron City.
- **06/01/2025, 14:00hrsLT | Hebron Old City:** Four civilians were arrested by Israeli Armed Forces in the Old City (H2 area) of Hebron.



Jerusalem Governorate

Five incidents were reported in the **Jerusalem Governorate**, involving search operations, arrests, and the use of tear gas by **Israeli Armed Forces**. These incidents occurred in **Bayt Duqqu, Al-Ram, Dahiyat al Bareed, Hizma**, and **Biddu**, reflecting ongoing Israeli security measures in urban and rural areas of the governorate.

The incidents primarily focused on search operations and enforcement actions targeting civilians for alleged violations, including entry permit issues. A notable incident involved the arrest of 30 civilian workers near the barrier in **Al-Ram** and **Dahiyat al Bareed**, underscoring the strict enforcement of movement restrictions in the region. Tear gas usage in **Al-Ram** also highlighted the use of force against civilians, resulting in health impacts from tear gas inhalation.

- **05/01/2025, 09:45hrsLT | Bayt Duqqu:** Three civilians were arrested during a search operation in Beit Duqqu village, northwest of Jerusalem, by Israeli Armed Forces.
- **05/01/2025, 11:00hrsLT | Al-Ram:** Tear gas was fired at civilians by Israeli Armed Forces near the barrier in Al-Ram town, north of Jerusalem, causing several Palestinians to suffer from tear gas inhalation. No arrests were reported.
- **05/01/2025, 23:00hrsLT | Dahiyat al Bareed:** Israeli Armed Forces arrested 30 civilian workers near the barrier in Al-Ram and Dahiyat al Bareed town, north of Jerusalem, reportedly for lacking Israeli entry permits.
- **06/01/2025, 00:45hrsLT | Hizma:** A search operation was carried out in Hizma village, northeast of Jerusalem, by Israeli Armed Forces. No arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 05:45hrsLT | Biddu:** Two civilians were arrested during a search operation in Biddu village, northwest of Jerusalem, by Israeli Armed Forces.

Ramallah Governorate

Three notable incidents were reported in the **Ramallah Governorate**, involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **Israeli settlers**. These incidents occurred in **Mikhmas, Ni'lin, Turmus'ayya**, and **Birzeit**, reflecting an escalating pattern of enforcement operations and settler violence. The incidents included land bulldozing, search operations, an arrest, and a violent settler attack involving arson.

The most significant escalation occurred in **Turmus'ayya**, where settlers attacked and set fire to houses, reflecting increasing inter-community tensions and risks to civilian safety and property. Meanwhile, search operations by Israeli Armed Forces in various locations highlighted ongoing security activities, including the arrest of a civilian in **Ni'lin**.

- **05/01/2025, 12:00hrsLT | Mikhmas:** Israeli settlers reportedly bulldozed land near Mikhmas village, southeast of Ramallah.
- **06/01/2025, 05:00hrsLT | Birzeit:** A search operation was carried out by Israeli Armed Forces in Birzeit town, north of Ramallah. No arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 22:30hrsLT | Turmus'ayya:** Israeli settlers attacked and set fire to houses in Turmus'ayya village, north of Ramallah. No injuries were reported.



Qalqiliya Governorate

Over the past 24 hours, two incidents were reported in the **Qalqiliya Governorate**, involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **Israeli settlers**. These incidents occurred in **Hajja** and **Immatain**, reflecting a mix of military activities and settler-related violence. The most significant incident involved an attack by settlers on Palestinian homes in **Immatain**, causing property damage and increasing tensions between communities.

- **05/01/2025, 23:30hrsLT | Hajja:** Israeli Armed Forces carried out a search operation in Hajja village, east of Qalqiliya. No arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 21:15hrsLT | Immatain:** Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian homes in Immatain village, east of Qalqiliya, causing property damage.

Salfit Governorate

Over the past 24 hours, two incidents were reported in the **Salfit Governorate**, involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **criminal actors**. These incidents occurred in **Marda** and **Ariel**, reflecting a combination of security operations and enforcement measures in response to reported criminal activities. The most significant incident involved **Israeli Armed Forces opening fire** at a civilian vehicle near the **Ariel settlement**, leading to the arrest of one civilian. Meanwhile, a stone-throwing incident near **Marda** prompted a search operation by Israeli Armed Forces, no arrests were reported.

- **05/01/2025, 23:30hrsLT | Marda:** Criminals reportedly threw stones at Israeli settlers' vehicles traveling near Marda village, north of Salfit. No injuries or damage were reported. Following the incident, Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation. No arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 17:30hrsLT | Ariel:** Israeli Armed Forces opened fire at a civilian vehicle traveling near Ariel settlement, north of Salfit. No injuries were reported, but one civilian was arrested.

Tubas Governorate

Three notable incidents were reported during this period in the **Tubas Governorate**, involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **Palestinian Armed Forces**. These incidents occurred in **Bardala**, **Tayasir**, and **El Far'a Camp**, reflecting a range of security-related activities, including search operations, IED disposal, and clashes. The most significant incident involved the safe disposal of IEDs by **Palestinian Armed Forces** near **Tayasir**, which prompted clashes but resulted in no injuries or arrests. Meanwhile, Israeli Armed Forces conducted multiple search operations in **Bardala** and **El Far'a Camp**, with some resulting in armed clashes.

- **05/01/2025, 10:00hrsLT | Bardala:** A school in Bardala village, east of Tubas, was searched by Israeli Armed Forces. No arrests were reported.
- **05/01/2025, 21:45hrsLT | Tayasir:** Palestinian Armed Forces safely disposed of several IEDs between Tayasir village, northeast of Tubas, and Tubas City. Clashes occurred, but no injuries or arrests were reported.
- **06/01/2025, 23:45hrsLT | El Far'a Camp:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted a search operation in El Far'a Camp, southwest of Tubas. Clashes ensued, but no injuries or arrests were reported.



Occupied Gaza Strip

North Gaza Governorate

The **North Gaza Governorate** has witnessed 27 incidents involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **De-Facto Authorities, Hamas**. These events occurred primarily in **Jabalia An-Nazla, As-Saftawi, Beit Lahia, and Jabalia Al-Balad**, and were characterized by airstrikes, shelling, ground incursions, and rocket launches. Significant civilian casualties, injuries, and property damage were reported, reflecting a severe escalation in conflict.

The incidents include targeted airstrikes on civilian areas, the use of quadcopters and shells by Israeli Armed Forces, and clashes during incursions. Hamas launched rockets towards Israel in response to Israeli military actions, adding to the conflict's intensity. Civilian infrastructure, including the **Indonesian Hospital**, was targeted, raising serious humanitarian concerns.

- **05/01/2025, 01:30hrsLT | Jabalia An-Nazla:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted an airstrike targeting the Jabalia An-Nazla area.
- **05/01/2025, 03:55hrsLT | Beit Lahia:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted incursions into Beit Hanoun, Beit Lahia, and Jabalia Camp, leading to armed clashes with Hamas forces.
- **05/01/2025, 03:55hrsLT | As-Saftawi:** Israeli Armed Forces troops opened fire towards the As-Saftawi neighbourhood, west of Jabalia.
- **05/01/2025, 12:30hrsLT | Jabalia An-Nazla:** An Israeli Armed Forces airstrike targeted a group of civilians in Jabalia An-Nazla, reportedly causing casualties.
- **05/01/2025, 16:50hrsLT | Jabalia Al-Balad:** Several shells were fired by Israeli Armed Forces towards An-Nazla, west of Jabalia Al-Balad.
- **06/01/2025, 03:55hrsLT | Beit Lahia:** Ongoing incursions by Israeli Armed Forces into Beit Hanoun, Beit Lahia, and Jabalia Camp resulted in continued clashes with Hamas.
- **06/01/2025, 09:01hrsLT | As-Saftawi:** Israeli Armed Forces troops continued firing towards the As-Saftawi neighbourhood, west of Jabalia, reportedly causing civilian injuries.
- **06/01/2025, 11:10hrsLT | As-Saftawi:** De-Facto Authorities, Hamas, reportedly launched three rockets from northern Gaza towards Israel in retaliation for ongoing Israeli military actions.
- **06/01/2025, 13:20hrsLT | Beit Lahia:** Israeli Armed Forces troops opened fire towards the Indonesian Hospital in Beit Lahia, reportedly injuring a civilian.
- **06/01/2025, 15:20hrsLT | Jabalia Al-Balad:** An airstrike by Israeli Armed Forces targeted Jabalia Al-Balad, reportedly causing significant damage to infrastructure.
- **06/01/2025, 17:26hrsLT | As-Saftawi:** Israeli Armed Forces used quadcopters to fire towards the As-Saftawi neighbourhood, west of Jabalia.
- **06/01/2025, 11:30hrsLT | As-Saftawi:** Several shells were fired by Israeli Armed Forces towards the As-Saftawi neighbourhood, causing further damage and heightening tensions.
- **06/01/2025, 13:00hrsLT | Jabalia An-Nazla:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted another airstrike targeting Jabalia An-Nazla, causing further civilian casualties and damage to property.



Gaza Governorate

The **Gaza Governorate** has experienced 34 incidents over this reporting period involving **Israeli Armed Forces**. The incidents included airstrikes, artillery fire, ground incursions, and the use of quadcopters. Key areas affected were **Ash-Sheikh Radwan, Az-Zaitoun, Ash-Shuja'iyah, As-Sabra, and Netzarim**, among others. Significant civilian casualties, injuries, and property destruction have been reported, reflecting a severe escalation of the conflict in Gaza City.

The most impactful incidents include airstrikes targeting civilian areas, causing deaths and injuries, and ongoing incursions into **Netzarim** and **Az-Zaitoun**, posing continuous threats to regional stability. Civilian neighbourhoods and key infrastructure have been significantly impacted.

- **05/01/2025, 02:35hrsLT | Ash-Shawa Yard:** Israeli Armed Forces struck a house near Ash-Shawa Yard in Gaza City. Civilian casualties were reported.
- **05/01/2025, 03:57hrsLT | Az-Zaitoun:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted an incursion east of Az-Zaitoun neighbourhood, southeast of Gaza City, posing risks to regional stability.
- **05/01/2025, 12:10hrsLT | As-Sabra:** Several shells were fired by Israeli Armed Forces towards the southern area of As-Sabra, contributing to operational escalation.
- **05/01/2025, 16:50hrsLT | Ash-Sheikh Radwan:** Israeli Armed Forces directed fire towards Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighbourhood, northwest of Gaza City, intensifying conflict activity.
- **05/01/2025, 17:40hrsLT | Ash-Shuja'iyah:** Israeli Armed Forces struck a group of civilians in Ash-Shuja'iyah, east of Gaza City, causing significant casualties.
- **06/01/2025, 01:50hrsLT | Ash-Sheikh Radwan:** An Israeli airstrike near Ash-Sheikh Radwan Water Pond resulted in the deaths of four civilians and injuries to others.
- **06/01/2025, 03:25hrsLT | Gaza City:** Israeli Armed Forces struck a house in central Gaza City, causing the death of one civilian and injuring others.
- **06/01/2025, 09:30hrsLT | Az-Zaitoun:** An Israeli Armed Forces airstrike near the Malaka area in Az-Zaitoun neighbourhood caused further escalation in the southeast of Gaza City.
- **06/01/2025, 13:00hrsLT | Yafa Street:** An airstrike was conducted by Israeli Armed Forces along Yafa Street, east of Gaza City, leading to significant property destruction.
- **06/01/2025, 16:20hrsLT | At-TOffah:** Israeli Armed Forces troops opened fire towards the At-TOffah neighbourhood, east of Gaza City, intensifying hostilities in the area.
- **06/01/2025, 16:55hrsLT | Al-Jalaa Street:** Israeli Armed Forces opened fire towards Al-Jalaa Street, northwest of Gaza City, injuring one civilian.
- **06/01/2025, 17:10hrsLT | At-TOffah:** A quadcopter operated by Israeli Armed Forces fired towards At-TOffah neighbourhood, east of Gaza City.
- **06/01/2025, 20:50hrsLT | Ash-Sheikh Radwan:** An Israeli Armed Forces airstrike targeted Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighbourhood, north of Gaza City, further destabilizing the area.
- **06/01/2025, 23:17hrsLT | Az-Zaitoun:** Israeli Armed Forces troops fired several shells towards Az-Zaitoun neighbourhood, southeast of Gaza City, intensifying conflict escalation.



Middle Area Governorate

The **Middle Area Governorate** experienced 44 incidents involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **criminal actors**. These incidents included airstrikes, shelling, ground incursions, and attacks on humanitarian aid operations. Key areas impacted were **An-Nuseirat Camp, Al-Bureij Camp, Deir Al-Balah, Al-Maghazi Camp,** and **Az-Zawaida**, with significant civilian casualties, injuries, and infrastructure damage reported. Notable incidents included airstrikes on residential areas and UNRWA vehicles, shelling of civilian neighbourhoods, and hijacking of humanitarian aid vehicles, further exacerbating the security and humanitarian crises.

- **05/01/2025, 0915hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** An Israeli Armed Forces quadcopter dropped several bombs targeting a school in An-Nuseirat Camp, intensifying the conflict.
- **05/01/2025, 1330hrsLT | Al-Birka Street:** An airstrike by Israeli Armed Forces targeted Al-Birka Street, west of Deir Al-Balah, resulting in civilian casualties and infrastructure damage.
- **05/01/2025, 1410hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** Israeli Armed Forces struck a house in An-Nuseirat Camp, killing three civilians and injuring several others.
- **05/01/2025, 1540hrsLT | Al-Bureij Camp:** An airstrike by Israeli Armed Forces targeted a building in Al-Bureij Camp, causing civilian injuries and structural damage.
- **05/01/2025, 2025hrsLT | Al-Bureij Camp:** Israeli Armed Forces conducted an airstrike on a house in Al-Bureij Camp, resulting in three civilian fatalities and several injuries.
- **06/01/2025, 0010hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** Israeli Armed Forces opened fire towards the north of An-Nuseirat Camp, causing further instability in the region.
- **06/01/2025, 1040hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** Israeli Armed Forces quadcopters dropped small-diameter bombs west of An-Nuseirat Camp, raising tensions in the vicinity.
- **06/01/2025, 1340hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** An airstrike by Israeli Armed Forces targeted Julies Street, north of An-Nuseirat Camp, causing civilian injuries and damage to property.
- **06/01/2025, 1410hrsLT | Al-Bureij Camp:** Israeli Armed Forces fired several shells towards the north of Al-Bureij Camp, contributing to civilian risks.
- **06/01/2025, 2003hrsLT | An-Nuseirat:** Shelling by Israeli Armed Forces targeted the northern areas of An-Nuseirat Camp, increasing the risk to civilians.
- **06/01/2025, 2130hrsLT | Al-Bureij Camp:** An airstrike conducted by Israeli Armed Forces targeted the northern part of Al-Bureij Camp, causing four civilian fatalities and additional injuries.
- **06/01/2025, 2130hrsLT | Al-Maghazi Camp:** An airstrike by Israeli Armed Forces hit a tent in Al-Maghazi Camp, leading to civilian injuries.
- **05/01/2025, 0627hrsLT | Az-Zawaida:** Armed criminals hijacked a UNRWA vehicle near Shabab Al-Zawaida Sports Club, stealing the vehicle and the driver's belongings before releasing the driver.
- **06/01/2025, 1400hrsLT | Az-Zawaida:** Armed hijackers intercepted three UNRWA trucks carrying flour, offloading the cargo before releasing the drivers and vehicles.



Khan Yunis Governorate

The **Khan Yunis Governorate** has experienced a total of 12 security related incidents involving **Israeli Armed Forces**. These incidents included airstrikes, artillery shelling, quadcopter attacks, and ongoing incursions. Areas such as **Al-Fukhari**, **Abasan**, **Khuza'a**, and **Bani Suheila** were significantly impacted, resulting in civilian casualties, injuries, and damage to infrastructure. The most critical incidents included the airstrike on **Asda'a Police Station**, which resulted in four civilian fatalities, and a targeted airstrike in **Abasan** that killed two civilians and injured others. The ongoing incursion in **Al-Fukhari** further contributes to the region's instability.

- **05/01/2025, 04:55hrsLT | Al-Fukhari:** The incursion by Israeli Armed Forces in Al-Fukhari, south-east of Khan Yunis, was reported.
- **05/01/2025, 09:10hrsLT | Qizan Rashwan:** An Israeli Armed Forces airstrike targeted the Motor Bike Market in Qizan Rashwan, south of Khan Yunis, causing destruction and escalating tensions.
- **05/01/2025, 15:03hrsLT | Asda'a Police Station:** Israeli Armed Forces attacked Asda'a Police Station, northwest of Khan Yunis, resulting in the deaths of four civilians.
- **06/01/2025, 05:02hrsLT | Al-Fukhari:** The ongoing incursion by Israeli Armed Forces in Al-Fukhari, southeast of Khan Yunis, remains active.

Rafah Governorate

The **Rafah Governorate** has experienced 18 security related incidents involving **Israeli Armed Forces** and **criminal actors**. These incidents included airstrikes, artillery shelling, ground incursions, and attacks on civilians. The most affected areas include **Ash-Shoka**, **Tal As-Sultan**, **Khirbet Al-Adas**, and **Rafah City**, resulting in civilian casualties, injuries, and property damage. Criminal activity, such as looting of fuel tankers and an attack on a health centre, exacerbated the already unstable environment. The most critical incidents include airstrikes on civilian gatherings in **Ash-Shoka** and **Khirbet Al-Adas**, which caused multiple fatalities and injuries, and the incursion into **Ash-Shoka** targeting key infrastructure like the Rafah crossing and the Philadelphi corridor.

- **05/01/2025, 04:12hrsLT | Ash-Shoka:** An intense incursion by Israeli Armed Forces was reported in the Ash-Shoka area, east of Rafah, including the Rafah crossing and the Philadelphi corridor.
- **05/01/2025, 15:15hrsLT | Miraj Junction:** Armed looters hijacked eight UNRWA fuel tankers near Miraj Junction, northeast of Rafah, disrupting humanitarian operations.
- **05/01/2025, 18:55hrsLT | Khirbet Al-Adas:** Israeli Armed Forces targeted a tok-tok (tricycle) in Khirbet Al-Adas, north of Rafah, resulting in the deaths of three civilians.
- **06/01/2025, 18:30hrsLT | Al Absi House:** Armed criminals stormed the Muawaia Health Centre (Al Absi House) in Mawasi Area, west of Rafah, causing minor property damage but no injuries.
- **06/01/2025, 05:03hrsLT | Tal As-Sultan:** Israeli Armed Forces carried out incursions across neighbourhoods in Tal As-Sultan, intensifying conflict in the area.
