today they have not done that. They may not use Patuxent Road as an access point for their landfill operations. Please note that I personally fought to purchase the Stachitas Property to be used for the new West County Elementary School and to reduce an access point for the landfill.

The ultimate fate of this project is in the hands of the Maryland Department of the Environment to determine if NWM has satisfied the requirements of the special exception order. County Executive Steuart Pittman sent a letter to MDE specifying the reasons why NWM is still not in compliance. We appreciate his support in fighting the landfill.

Hopefully it is determined that NWM is not in compliance and their special exception will be allowed to finally expire. No community should have to live with something like this over their heads for so long. I will continue to stand alongside you and fight to keep this project from moving forward.
