Subject: Support S-2588 and H-7756 Relating to Human Services-Medical Assistance Long Term Care Service and Finance Reform

Please accept this letter in support of the submitted bill S-2588 and H-7756 Relating to Human Services-Medical Assistance Long Term Care Service and Finance Reform. **These bills will provide for patient site encounter mobile dentistry visits be increased to \$180 per visit and will expand the availability of this service to additional community-based settings including group homes, assisted living facilities, adult day health and intellectual and developmental disabilities day programs**. In doing so, the bills provide for increased access to multiple populations that have been evidenced to have difficulty accessing basic dental services in RI.

The mobile dentistry encounter site visit reimbursement was first established in 2008. Although this provided for some improved access for individuals living in nursing homes, it failed to provide for the population living in, or attending, long term care community-based settings. Additionally, the reimbursement amount for this service has not been increased since its initial introduction and does not cover the cost of delivering this critical care.

The importance of accessing quality basic oral healthcare is paramount. The health of the teeth and mouth is central to a person's overall health and well-being and maintaining good oral health is evidenced to result in an overall healthcare cost savings. Poor oral healthcare results in a higher incidence of, pneumonia, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, bone loss and cancer; all situations increasing the frequency of accessing medical care resulting in higher costs.
