Turn your dimes into dollars for PACC

PACC now has an account with Return-It Express. Just bag and drop your returnable beverage containers in a clear plastic bag - no sorting required. **Tip:** only put a maximum of 12 glass bottles in a bag to prevent breakage. **NOTE: We will be penalized \$1 for any garbage in the bag or any unaccepted containers (e.g. American drink containers, buttermilk or whipping cream containers).**

Take your bags to the express check-in at either of our local Return-It depots and print off a PACC label using our phone number – **604-531-0244** – to access the account on the tablet. **Stick label on and scan code.**

REMEMBER – EVEN THOUGH THE CLUB IS CLOSED IN THE SUMMER, YOU CAN STILL DEPOSIT YOUR CONTAINERS AND SUPPORT THE FUNDRAISER.

Practice Ice reservation system:

The club is very busy. We have Practice Ice on Mondays and Wednesday. You can book a sheet and it will be prepared for you at a cost of \$10 for 30-minutes. Paid practice ice will be mopped, pebbled and nipped. If a sheet is not booked then it will be first come first serve but no service to the ice will be done. Every night there is two sheets open after 8:45 pm and is free for PACC members to use. The ice may be or may not be prepped. If the system is down – which has been the case please email me if you want prepared ice and you can pay in person. There is a glitch in system so just email me and I can book it .

This is a trial run, and the club reserves the right to change the rules at any time.
