## **Practice ice reservation rules:**

Practice Ice on Tuesday will be first come first serve. 30-minute time on ice unless no one is waiting.

Reservations are for sheet 1-2 are for Team reservation only, (**NO singles**). Must be a Peace Arch Club Curler.

Two weeks ahead max booking during regular season. \$20 per hour online via our reservation system, or payable at the pro shop on arrival. 24 hours notice for cancellations. Sheets 3- 4 will be for singles players 30 min max \$10. Unless demand indicates a need for more of either. Paid practice ice will be mopped, pebbled and nipped. If a sheet is not booked then it will be first come first serve but no service to the ice will be done.

This is a trial run, and the club reserves the right to change the rules at any time.

# **The Ice Report**

After a lengthy install we have ice. You will find it cold to the touch so don't touch it. It is clean with a few blemishes due to leaks and a mystery footprint. Rocks have been touched up this year. We spun them to make the running surface smaller so hopefully we can get some more curl to last longer.

The building is very humid so you might see some drops on the ice from the ceiling. As winter approaches we will get drier air so that should end.

Clean shoes equals clean ice. Get new grippers before they are all sold out.
