PACC now has an account with Return-It Express. Just bag and drop your returnable beverage containers in a clear plastic bag - no sorting required. **Tip:** only put a maximum of 12 glass bottles in a bag to prevent breakage.

NOTE: We will be **penalized** \$1 for any garbage in the bag or any unaccepted containers (e.g. American drink containers, buttermilk or whipping cream containers).

Take your bags to the **express check-in** at either of our local Return-It depots and print off a PACC label using our phone number – **604-531-0244** – to access the account on the tablet. **Stick label on your bag** and don't forget to scan the label. **IF THE LABEL ISN'T SCANNED, YOUR RECYLED ITEMS DON'T GET RECORDED.**

Check out our progress on the chart posted on the office window. **As of January 31, we have raised a total of \$244.** Keep those cans and bottles coming.

News from Curl BC

Fee Increases coming from Curl Canada for next year

Curl Canada will be replacing its current \$2 Individual member Fee (IMF) with a \$5 Curling Development Fee (CDF) in the 2025-26 season. The CDF is a per capita assessment collected from every individual curler, at every affiliated curling club in Canada. The goal is to transform individual contribution into collective impact on developing community, knowledge, leaders, markets, programs, and technology. The CDF will be invoiced separately from the \$22 Curl BC membership fee. Thus, full fees for regular curlers will increase to \$27 next season. Curlers must pay both fees in order to maintain status as a member of Curl BC enabling their club to vote at the Curl BC AGM and curlers to enter BC Curling Championships.
