Compliance with these Rules and Regulations are intended as a guide for the Derby and are in NO WAY A GUARANTEE AGAINST INJURY OR DEATH before, during and after the event. Drivers and crews are responsible for their own life and health insurance.

1. Derby drivers and crew are independent contractors, not employees of the Association or promoter and must have signed the release sheet to be allowed in the pit area or on the track. Drivers ages 16 and 17 must have legal guardian signature.

2. Unsportsmanlike conduct, rules violations, under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or the use of such, are prohibited prior to or during the event. Any of the above will not be tolerated and can cause forfeiture of winnings or grounds for disqualification or barring from future derbies.

3. Drivers must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Drivers must drive the car they sign in on.

4. No mower will be allowed in the competition area prior to the heat in which it is to participate in. When heat starts you must stay in your mower. Do not leave your mower unless you are told to do so by an official or the last car has stopped. 5. Registration opens at 11:30 a.m. No mower in infield before 11:30 a.m. without permission. Pre-entries must be checked in by 4:00 p.m. Inspection is 12:00 Noon to 5:25 p.m. Drivers meeting 5:30 p.m. You will shut mower off and get out when being inspected. Each mower is allowed one time through inspection and once for recheck. No third time. Any changes made after passing inspection mower will be disqualified. You have 30 minutes to get through inspection after enter pit, unless exceed 5:15 p.m. Then you must pass at that time and there will be no recheck. Mowers will be cut off at 5:15 p.m. to enter pit. Drivers maneuver forward and backward. Twenty-minute time limit on heats, if time exceeds will draw. Thirty-second-time limitation on hit. If stopped for sandbagging and driver warned, hit time is reduced to 15 seconds. Deliberate hitting of driver's cab or header to header the mower will be disqualified. Officials reserve the right to inspect any and all mowers entered at any time. 6. If an emergency arises during any event, all mowers will be stopped. If any mower(s) must be moved, the heat will "restart" from present position. 7. All drivers are required to fill out an entry form. Derby officials may accept or reject any and all entries. Heats and features will be determined by entries. All drivers must supply their own mowers and may enter as many heats as they wish. However, if driver makes feature, that mower will run feature and any other mowers will be withdrawn from any further heats. Feature mowers will be in holding area, no work to be done until last heat mowers enter holding area.

REMOVAL OF MOWERS

All mowers participating in the Derby must be removed from the fairgrounds within 4 hours after the show is over unless otherwise approved by superintendent. Mower owner or driver that can't supply proof of removal will be required a deposit that will be returned after mower is removed. Any mower(s) left, or any other parts Fairboard or official will have them removed, and driver will be responsible for removal fees.

General Rules for ALL Classes:

 All drivers must be 16 years or older (16-17 years of age must have a guardian sign waiver). All drivers must sign a waiver prior to entering the derby holding no one responsible but yourself for anything that may happen. Participate at your own risk.
 Drivers must wear long sleeve shirt and pants. Helmet and eye protection is required. Neck brace and seat belt recommended.

3.No sandbagging allowed or team driving. Everyone hits everyone. You will be warned once then disqualified. Judges decision final.

4.You must hit with front of mower during the derby. Hits are to be made to front and tires of other mowers only. Any intentional hit to rear of mower could result in being disqualified.

5. Front mounted engines only are allowed on mowers, no rear mount, or zero turn mowers.

6.Engine must be factory mower engine no large than 25 hp., and must be belt driven.

7.Electric start mower preferred, you must be able to start your mower from your seat. No lying across the hood to start the mower.

8.Decks must be removed. All plastic and lights must be removed

9. You may use any seat that will fit on top of the back of mower.

10.Must have good brakes and forward and reverse gears at start of derby. 11.Spark plug and carburetor protectors are allowed. Do not get carried away, official's decision is final.

12.Exhaust must not extend out from mower hood area. NO STACKS allowed.
13.If gas tank or battery is in front of engine you must move it to a safe place. Battery and gas tank must be secured and covered. Gas cover and tank must not leak or you will not run.

14.Leg guards are mandatory and must be bolted or welded from rear fender to front of foot rest or frame. May not be attached to front bumper. Must not protect tires in any way.

15.Any mower with unsafe leg guard or any guard that falls off during event will not be allowed to continue.

16.Shifter guard is recommended to protect your hand/arm if shifter is mounted on fender. Hand throttle is allowed.

17.No grill guards on the front of mower. No kickers or braces from front bumper to leg guards.

18. Hood must stay stock and intact with the exception of replacing plastic/fiberglass hoods with sheet metal. Must stay same/style as the original. Hoods may be bolted, wired or chained down.

19.Engine bay area may be reinforced but must be contained inside the hood and maintain factory body lines.

20.Modification of drive pulleys is allowed ubt must stay belt driven. No chain, shaft, or friction drive mowers allowed.

21.Trans axles remain factory but reinforcing or welding of spider gears is permitted. 22.Frames must be stock. Frames may have repair welds. Frames may have added metal to attach bumpers. Mounting brackets no longer than 12".

23.Front and rear bumpers are allowed. Bumpers CANNOT extend beyond inside of tires! Bottom of front and rear bumpers must be at AXLE height! Bumpers can be NO LARGER than 3" x 3" and not extend out more than 4" from frame to front of bumper. No spikes, sharp edges, or V bumpers allowed. If you want to run they will have to be cut off. Official's decision final.

24.A back seat bar is allowed. This is to protect the back of the seat. This bar may be mounted to leg protection structure or rear bumper but must not protect the rear wheels in any way!

25.Tires must be turf/lawn mower tires. No dually or bar tread tires. Air in tires only, no foam or fluids – you will be disqualified.

26.FOR YOUR SAFETY – If a mower rolls over all participants must stop and wait until the mower is upright and driver okayed.

27.All mowers must have a number displayed on hood of mower.
