

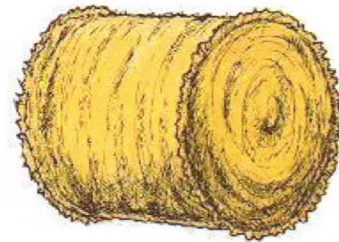
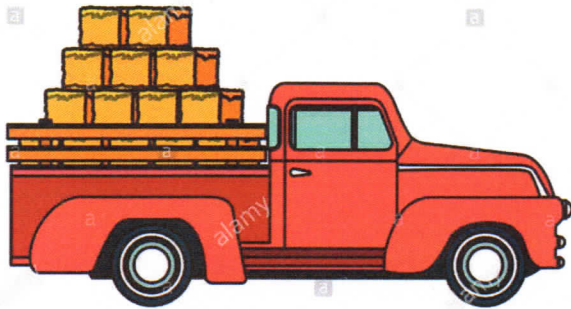

2022 Round Bale Race



Returning for another year, Round Bale Race at the **Williams County Fair** **will be held Sunday Night, September 11th** at the Williams County Fair near the Horse Arena during the Junior Fair Board hosted Fun Night beginning at 7:00 PM. Teams will have to race round bales down the track

Rules:

1. All participants must check in prior to race time. Pre-Registration would be appreciated. The Entry fee is \$5.00 per person (non-refundable.)
2. All participants must sign a release and waiver of liability agreement form, participants under the age of 18 must have a Minors Release form signed by a parent or legal guardian.
3. A team is needed to participate in the contest. A team should consist of at least two (2) participants and no more than a maximum of four (4) participants.
4. Participants must be at least 14 years of age or older.
5. Any action deemed unsafe or inappropriate by contest judges or officials warrants disqualification.
6. The judges' decision is final and there will be no protests.
7. Role a round bale of straw 75 feet.
8. The race course will be divided into two lanes.
9. Races will be in heats of two (2) teams at a time. The winning team will advance to the next round and the losing team will be eliminated.

The winner will be declared from a single elimination bracket. First place receives a cash prize of \$60.00 / Second place receives \$40.00.

Registration will close Sunday September 11th at 7:00 p.m.

Turn in the completed form to the Jr. Fair Office, along with the entry fee. Any pre-registered teams may pay their fee Sunday prior to the events.

2022 Bale Hauling (Truck) Contest



Returning for another year, Bale Hauling Contest at the **Williams County Fair will be held Sunday Night September 11th** at the Williams County Fair near the Horse Arena during the Junior Fair Board hosted Fun Night beginning at 7:00 PM.

Along with loading bales, participants are to maneuver through an obstacle course with their truck to unload the bales neatly stacked in a designated area.

Rules:

1. All participants must check in prior to race time and sign a release and waiver of liability agreement. Pre-Registration would be appreciated.
2. All participants must sign a release and waiver of liability agreement form, participants under the age of 18 must have a Minors Release form signed by a parent or legal guardian.
3. The \$20 entry fee per team is non-refundable.
4. Any action deemed unsafe or inappropriate by contest judges or officials warrants immediate disqualification.
5. The judges' decision is final and there will be no protests.
6. The Participants furnish their truck for the contest. NO FLATBED TRUCKS... Driver must be at least 16 and have a valid driver's license.
7. A "red flag" means to stop the run immediately.
8. Standing on the truck cab is prohibited.
9. Each team will have three members.
10. Teams will haul 35 bales. (Subject to change)
11. Teams will load bales, drive once around the track and unload bales in the designated area. Bales must be stacked neatly!!!!
12. Time starts when the 1st door is opened. Time stops when all team members are back in the truck with all doors closed.
13. All team members will ride inside the truck.
14. All dropped bales must be picked up unless broken. It is at the discretion of the team to stop and pick up lost bales or to retrieve them while unloading.
15. After 4 broken bales, Team will be stopped and disqualified from the contest.
16. This is a timed event with penalties as follows:
 - a. 10-second penalty for each course violation (i.e. hitting cone)
 - b. 10-second penalty for each door not closed when the truck is moving.
 - c. 10-second penalty for each not closed when loading or unloading bales (doors must be closed before first bale hits the truck or ground)
 - d. 10-second penalty for each bale not in designated unloaded area
 - e. 10-second penalty for each broken bale.

The team who completed the course with the fastest time wins. First place receives a cash prize of \$90.00 / Second place receives \$60.00.

Registration will close Sunday September 11th at 7:00 p.m.

Turn in the completed form to the Jr. Fair Office, along with the entry fee. Any pre-registered teams may pay their fee Sunday prior to the events.
