

1900 Club Code of Conduct

- Gratitude, respect and common courtesy are the guidelines to promote self-improvement and sobriety to all persons so inclined.
- No alcohol or drugs are allowed on the 1900 Club property.
- No illegal weapons allowed on 1900 Club property.
- Gambling, Panhandling and other solicitation is prohibited.
- All group meetings shall be respected and not interfered with in any manner.
- Sleeping is not allowed on the premises; this includes the club building and parking lot.
- No overnight parking.
- No smoking in or within 25 feet of the club building and only in designated smoking areas.
- Children must be in the company of a guardian/parent at all times. Unattended children and parents will be asked to leave.
- Only service animals, as defined by federal, state and municipal law, are allowed and must be on a leash at all times.
- Abusive language is not permitted and obscene language should be avoided.
- Threats or violent behavior towards anyone on 1900 Club property will not be tolerated. Appropriate action will be taken to deal with such instances up to and including permanent expulsion from the Club and/or calling the police.

Everyone is responsible for complying with these guidelines. Your cooperation will help to make the 1900 Club a safe, clean place for recovery, sociability and service for all.
