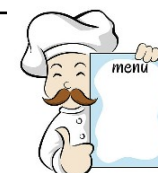

FRANK F. COBB MEMORIAL TROPHY—AWARDED SATURDAY AM SHOW

As a lasting reminder of his faithful stewardship to our club and to the Bulldog breed, the Oklahoma City Bulldog Club offers at the Saturday AM Specialty Show the Frank F. Cobb Memorial Trophy. This trophy shall be awarded to the Best of Breed winner if the winner is the breeder/owner/exhibitor. Permanent possession of the Frank F. Cobb Memorial Trophy shall be awarded if the trophy is won three times by the same breeder/owner/exhibitor, but not necessarily with the same Bulldog.

SWEEPSTAKES (OKCBC Saturday AM Show)

Sweepstakes is open to breeders and owners of Bulldogs on the day of the show are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Entrants must also be entered in a Regular Class of the show. A Champion of Record may not be entered or shown. Professional Handlers may show their OWN DOGS ONLY.

Puppy Dogs (6 mos & under 9 mos) Puppy Bitches (6 mos & under 9 mos)
Puppy Dogs (9 mos & under 12 mos) Puppy Bitches (9 mos & under 12 mos)

Best in Sweepstakes Competition

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

Placements in each class will receive a proportionate awards of the entry money received by the Club for the total entries in that class. The Club will retain 40% of total sweepstakes entry fees for administrative purposes. Sweepstakes money not awarded will be retained by the Club.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (OKCBC Saturday PM Show)

Novice Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won ten (10) first place awards in an open class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1- October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility timeframe for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (OKCBC Shows Only)

Veteran Dog/Veteran Bitch : For dogs and bitches 6 years of age and older. Open to Champions and Non-Champions alike. Dogs/Bitches judged separately.

Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Dog/Bitch class at Independent Specialties.

The following classes/events are not offered at any of these shows:

Novice Dog/Bitch, Brood Bitch, Stud Dog, Rescue Parade, Parade of Champions

IMPORTANT– TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (CH 11, Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging at this show.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER HANDLER SERIES (all shows)

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition. The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be allowed to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

SHOW & SHOW SITE RULES

- All Bulldogs will be judged on a ramp
- No dogs are to be left in show area overnight. Dogs must only be exercised in the designated outdoor exercise area
- Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccines
- Grooming and crate set-up areas will be designated. Only small battery-operated crate fans are allowed. There will be no reserved grooming at the show, but plenty of space will be available
- Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded 3 point majors provided the number of entries competing meets the requirements of AKC for Reserve Winners to be awarded points.
- Admission to show is free
- Show room will have a concrete floor
- Smoking is prohibited inside the building
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at Show Site
- Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed, or served during show hours. Local authorities may check for violations of this policy, and if found, the Show will be ended!
- Parents and Guardians must keep children under control at all times on the show grounds. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Bulldogs are expected to be judged on a ramp.

No dogs or puppies are to be sold at the show site.

1. The AKC respects the right of all individuals to express and advocate personal opinions in lawful ways.

2. Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club (AKC) Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or owner's Agent entering a dog or a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete. Conditional entries are not accepted.

3. ENTRIES CLOSE 9PM CST, WEDNESDAY, SEPT 9, 2026 at the Show Secretary's address. Laura Anninos 8115 E Harvard Circle, Denver, CO 80231, laura.anninos@gmail.com. **Make checks payable to Laura Anninos** No cash will be accepted.

5. Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from the Show Secretary or may be obtained from the AKC.

6. AKC fees \$4.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2). Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank.

7. Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank.

8. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, natural disaster, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

9. There will be a \$50 fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds. All check must be drawn in US Funds.

10. A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.

11. Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of a discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Secretary should be advised at once. Trophies not claimed on the day of show are forfeited.



AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
