Tom Brusca was just short of brilliant at third base making a number of outstanding plays and keying two of the double plays. George Cohan, Mers long time team leader and ironman, was flawless at shortstop not only handling all ground balls near him but making a couple of real nice plays going back on some Texas league pop-ups. Joe Girimonte and Jim Fileccia handled their second and first base positions to perfection with Girimonte continuing to show he is the best second baseman in the league by quickly and perfectly turning each double play.
