The OTHG played a full schedule on Aug 26th to make up for the "HEAT WAVE" cancellation on July 22nd.

The OTHG season wound down this past weekend as Paradox Cafe took on Moby Drugs in the early game on the 60 foot field. The rivalry heated up in the first few innings as Paradox took a 9-6 lead. The floodgates then opened up as Paradox went on a hit attack with the top 5 men in the order scoring 17 runs.
