e. any information in any format that shows involvement, planning, directing, or evaluating the effectiveness or value of the past, present, and future riots.

edited, or deleted, such as logs, phonebooks, saved usernames and passwords, documents, and browsing history;

This warrant authorizes a review of electronic storage media and electronically stored information seized or copied pursuant to this warrant in order to locate evidence, fruits, and instrumentalities described in this warrant. The review of this electronic data may be conducted by any government personnel assisting in the investigation, who may include, in addition to law enforcement officers and agents, attorneys for the government, attorney support staff, and technical experts. Pursuant to this warrant, the FBI may deliver a complete copy of the seized or copied electronic data to the custody and control of attorneys for the government and their support staff for their independent review.

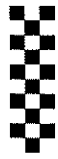

24 ON OCTOBER 17, 2020, AT APPROXIMATELY 2035 HOURS WHILE RESPONDING TO A
25 SCHEDULED PROTEST THAT WAS OCCURRING IN THE AREA OF DOWNTOWN
26 PHOENIX, RYDER COLLINS COMITTED UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY, RIOT AND
27 OBSTRUCTING A THOROUGHFARE, AFTER HE JOINED A GROUP THAT WAS CAUSING
28 A MAJOR DISTURBANCE, DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY AND CIVIL UNREST. DURING
THIS TIME, WE GAVE ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE LONG-RANGE ACOUSTIC DEVICE
THAT THE INDIVIDUALS NEEDED TO GET OUT OF THE ROADWAY. RYDER DID NOT
COMPLY AND CONTINUED TO BE IN THE ROADWAY TAKING PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE

1 GROUP AND POLICE OFFICERS. THE LONG-RANGE ACOUSTIC DEVICE DECLARED
2 THE DEMONSTRATION AN UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY AND RYDER STILL CONTINUED TO
3 STAY WITH THE GROUP AND DID NOT LEAVE THE AREA. AS OFFICERS
4 APPROACHED AND AFTER NUMEROUS WARNINGS TO DISPERSE, RYDER STAYED
5 NEAR THE GROUP AND WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY. I WITNESSED SERGEANT
6 GROAT 6179 AT 100 W VAN BUREN ST GIVE A LAWFUL ORDER TO RYDER TO STOP
7 MOVING TOWARDS THE MASS ARREST THAT WAS OCCURRING TO BE LAWFULLY
8 DETAINED FOR UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY, RIOT AND OBSTRUCTING A
9 THOROUGHFARE. IMMEDIATELY, RYDER IGNORED SERGEANT GROATS COMMANDS
10 AND STARTED TO WALK SOUTHBOUND ON N 1ST AVE BEFORE BEING PLACED
11 UNDER ARREST BY PHOENIX POLICE OFFICERS WITHOUT INCIDENT AT
12 APPROXIMATELY 2035 HOURS. RYDER WAS TRANSPORTED TO CENTRAL CITY
13 PRECINCT TO BE BOOKED. ON 10/18/2020 AT APPROXIMATELY 0100 HOURS, AT
14 CENTRAL CITY PRECINCT, I READ RYDER COLLINS HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS FROM A
15 DEPARTMENT ISSUED MIRANDA RIGHTS CARD AND RYDER RESPONDED, YES SIR,
16 TO UNDERSTANDING HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS. AFTER RYDER UNDERSTOOD HIS
17 MIRANDA RIGHTS, RYDER ADMITTED TO FOLLOWING THE PROTEST GROUP
18 AROUND THE DOWNTOWN AREA WHILE TAKING PHOTOGRAPHS OF THEM AND THE
19 POLICE. RYDER ADMITTED THAT HE DID HEAR THE ANNOUNCEMENTS AND
20 APPOLOGIZED FOR NOT LEAVING THE AREA WHEN LAWFULLY ORDERED TO DO SO.
21 RYDER TOLD ME THAT HE WAS MOVING AROUND THE GROUP AND POLICE WHILE
22 THE PROTEST OCCURRED TO GET DIFFERENT ANGLES OF PHOTOS. RYDER WAS
23 LATER TRANSPORTED TO 4TH AVE JAIL.

ON OCTOBER 17, 2020 A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS KNOWN AS "ACAB" WHICH MEANS
"ALL COPS ARE BASTARDS" GATHERED AT THE UNIVERSITY PARK LOCATED AT 1002
WEST VAN BUREN STREET AT APPROXIMATELY 1903 HOURS. THE SCHEDULED
PROTEST WAS ORGANIZED BY THE GROUP "ACAB" AND MEMBERS OF THE GROUP
WERE IDENTIFIED BY THEIR CLOTHING ALONG WITH INFORMATION GATHERED BY
THE PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM PREVIOUS CONTACTS. SEARCH
WARRANTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED ON PREVIOUS ARRESTS RELATED TO THIS
GROUP DURING THE PROTESTS. THE ORGANIZERS OF THIS "ACAB" GROUP
COMMUNICATE THROUGH AND APPLICATION ON THEIR CELLULAR PHONE CALLED
"SIGNAL" TO SET A DATE, TIME AND LOCATION FOR THE MEETING WHICH WAS USED
FOR THIS INCIDENT ON OCTOBER 17, 2020.

ON OCTOBER 17, 2020 A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS FROM A GROUP KNOWN AS ACAB
ALL COPS ARE BASTARDS MEET AT THE UNIVERSITY PARK, LOCATED AT 1002 WEST
VAN BUREN STREET. ACAB IS KNOWN TO DISRUPT THE VEHICLE TRAFFIC AND
BUSINESS ACCESS WHEN THEY ARE PROTESTING. THEY ARE ALSO KNOWN TO
CONDUCT CRIMINAL ACTS.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1903 HOURS IN THE AREA OF 10TH AVE AND VAN BUREN ST AT
THE PARK 1002 W VAN BUREN A GROUP THAT IS KNOWN AS ACAB ALL COPS ARE
BASTARDS BEGAN TO FORM AS A GROUP. BETWEEN 1903 HOURS AND 2000 HOURS,

1 NUMEROUS INDIVIDUALS ENTERED THE PARK AND SEVERAL WERE CARRING
2 UMBRELLAS.

3 AT APPROXIMATELY 2000 HOURS, WE COULD HEAR SEVERAL SPEECHES FROM
