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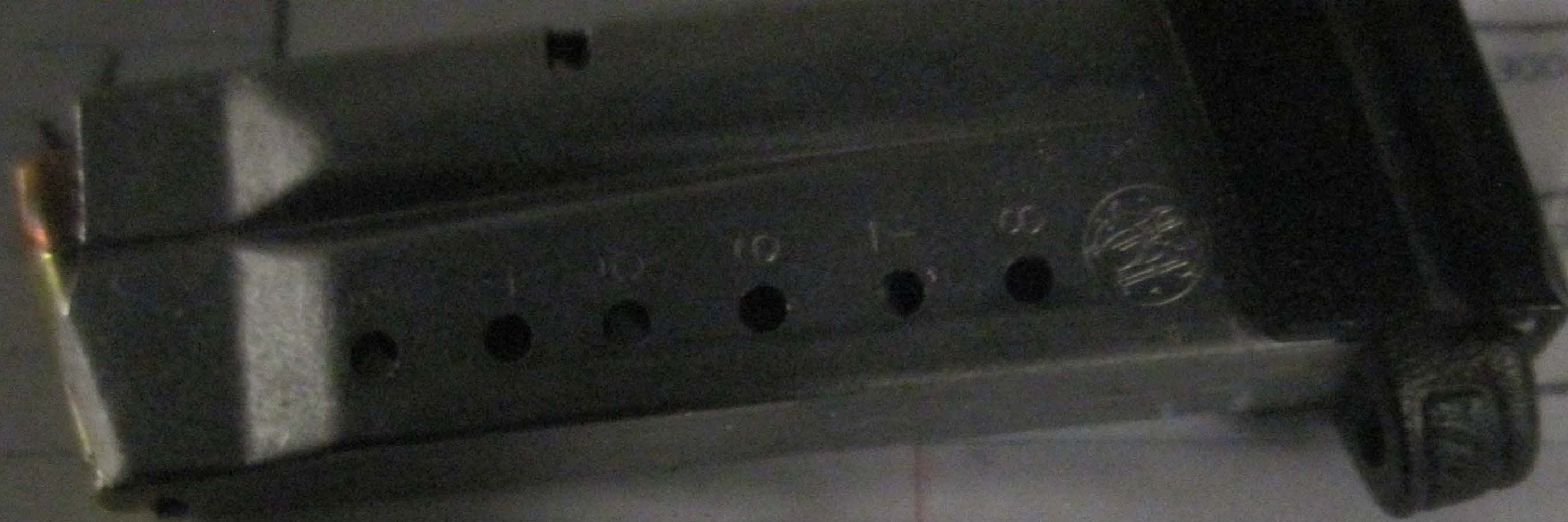

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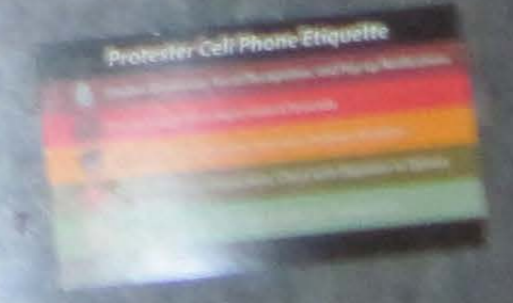
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## Protester Cell Phone Etiquette

 Disable Fingerprint, Facial Recognition, and Pop-up Notifications

 Use an 8 Digit (Or Longer) Unlock Passcode


 Do Not Post Media Online That Outs Protester Identities


 Record All Police Interactions, Check with Organizer to Upload.


 Use Signal or Telegram Messengers to Communicate

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**Advice for Before a March or Protest Begins:**

**Buddy System:**

**Give your legal name and DOB to another person**

**Check-in With Organizer or an LE**

**Get Bail # info, know where to send name/DOB info**

**If You are Being Arrested--Stay Calm**

**Police will look to add resisting arrest charges**

**Law Enforcement will Intentionally Misinterpret Your Wording!**

**If You are Being Held By Police, Clearly State the Following:**

**"Am I Free to Leave?"**

**"I Am Invoking My Right to Remain Silent"**

**"I Am Invoking My Right to an Attorney"**
