## ❖ Rules & Regulation

1. The Participating Federations/ Associations must be registered entity in their respective district, state, nation.
2. All participating Federations/ Associations will be offered complimentary (free) membership of IACS initially for one year i.e. 2019-20. Afterwards, membership status will be subject to the commitment and dedication of respective entities with IACS which includes defined membership fee and other relevant charges whatsoever will be applicable and decided by IACS Board.
3. All interested International/ National Federations/ Associations related to Combative Sports including any type of Martial Arts may register themselves before 15 November, 2019 through the official process by contacting at IACS headquarter via email at [combativesports@hotmail.com](mailto:combativesports@hotmail.com)
4. All Players/ Officials must be a registered member of IACS or with any associate organizations.
5. The selection of participating athletes and officials will be conducted by concerned Combative/ Martial Arts Committees/ Units or associate Combative /Martial Arts Organizations and communicated to IACS Headquarter well before the deadline, if concerned information will be received after the deadline then IACS is fully authorized to restrict the participation of athletes/ officials and no refund will be applicable. In this regard, if any issue requires any immediate action, will be done accordingly in one month after the completion of event.
6. All National and International delegation must ensure that all the participants should have their own equipment & other protective guards as per rules. The OCICG or any member will not be the contact point for any such queries before and during the games.
7. Organizing Committee has the right to accept or reject the entry of any individual or teams.
8. All technical officials should wear official uniform as per rules of concerned federations/ associations/ organizations.
9. The tournament officials reserve the right to suspend or terminate the match/ player/ team for infringement of the rules.
10. In case of injury or any misshaping during the games, only first-aid facilities will be provided by Organizing Committee.
11. The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any injuries, damages, losses, theft before, during and after the championship.
12. Alcoholic drinks, smoking, chewing tobacco and drugs are strictly prohibited at the competition venue, Games Village (accommodation areas) before, during and after the event.
13. Entry fee will not be refundable in any case. The Organizing Committee has the right of accepts or refuses the entry of any individual, officials or teams.
14. The participants, below the age of 18 yrs he/she has to produce the relevant evidence/ proof of his/her date of birth.
15. Please attach Date of Birth Certificate, Health and Fitness Certificate issued by concerned authorities.
16. No Conveyance / Transport will be provided before, during and after International Combat Games for Players & Officials. However, in exceptional circumstances OCICG may amend the rules.
17. If there are less than three entries in any event, technical committee will ensure the maximum possibility for participation of athlete in other joint category.
18. The rules of International Federations/ Organizaions/ Associations will be applicable for their respective discipline.
19. Seprate Arenas will be provided for all sports and games.
