### Statutory Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

#### ATTENDED FUNERAL

##### Funeral Director's Charges Only

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

**£ 1,995**

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements **£ 595**
- Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death into the funeral director's care **£ 295**  
Within Scotland.
- Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities **£ 325**  
The deceased person will rest at the Funeral Home, Kilmallie Road premises.
- Providing a suitable coffin **£ 375**  
Made from veneered oak.
- Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director **No Charge**  
Where viewing is requested by the client.
- At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle **£ 405**

#### UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

- Burial (funeral director's charges only) **£ 995**
- Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)<sup>2</sup> **£ 1,495**

#### FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.<sup>1</sup>

- In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is **£ 300 - £1,003**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.<sup>2</sup>

- In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents **£ 450 - £1,003**

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.  
<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
