BAKER BOWLING

One team member bowls frames 1, 3, 5, 7, & 9,

The other team member bowls frames 2, 4, 6, 8, & 10 for a total team score.

This is a handicap tournament - Handicap shall be 90% from 230

For handicap purposes we will use the highest 2020/2021 yearbook average. If no 2020/2021 average is available we will use the most recent published yearbook average going back 3 years, or a current season league sheet must be presented.

Bowlers without a verifiable average will use an entering average of 230

Questionable averages may be re-rated by the Tournament Director

Lanes will be randomly assigned

Bowlers to receive 15 minutes of practice

Bowlers will stay on the odd/even lane for the entire qualifying round, anchoring every other game.

Bowlers will move to a new pair after each 2 game baker set

At the end of 6 games any ties will be broken by the team score of the last game bowled

After 6 Baker games the top 16 teams with handicap will advance to head to head match play. Head to head competition will be #1 seed vs. #16, #2 seed vs. #15, etc. During match play, teams may select the anchor bowler.

Match play will consist of one baker game with the team with the highest handicap score advancing until we get to the final two teams. The final round will be two baker games with handicap, total pins determine the champion.

This is a Non-USBC certified event, however, USBC tournament rules apply
