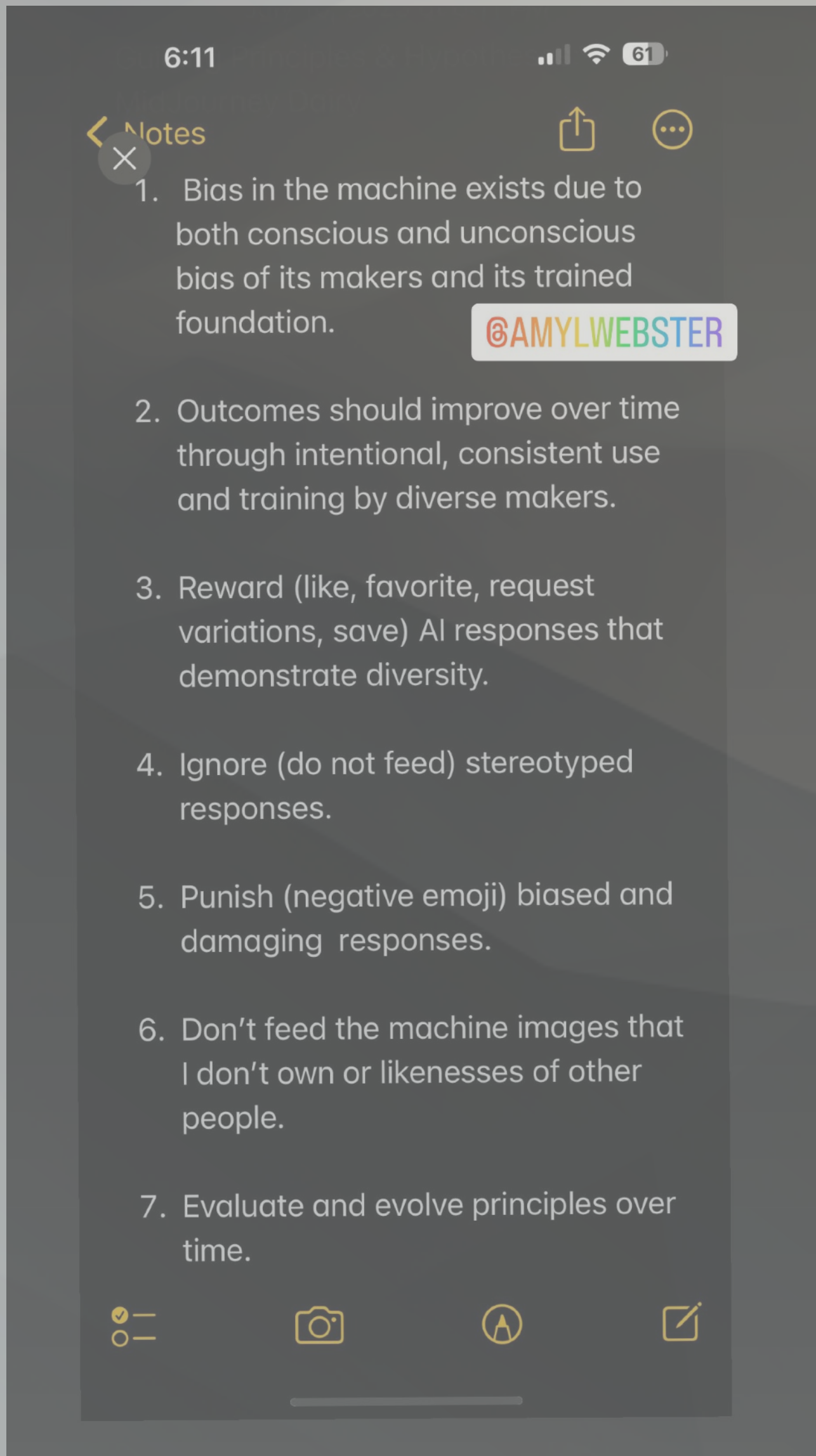


Responsible Use Principles (v1.1)

1. Bias in the machine exists due to both conscious and unconscious bias of its makers and its trained foundation.
2. Outcomes should improve over time through intentional, consistent use and training by diverse makers.
3. Reward (like, favorite, request variations, save) AI responses that demonstrate diversity.
4. Ignore (do not feed) stereotyped responses.
5. Punish (negative emoji) biased and damaging responses.
6. Don't feed the machine images that I don't own or likenesses of other people.
7. Evaluate and evolve principles over time.
8. Know how to report safety violations and actively report.
