### **Abbreviations and Symbols Chart:**

○	CH or Ch - CHAIN	INC - INCREASE	
•	Sist - SLIP STITCH	DEC - DECREASE	
×	SC - SINGLE CROCHET STITCH	T	HDC - HALF DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH
F	DC - DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH	F	TC - TREBLE CROCHET STITCH
↻	TURN		

### **Additional Abbreviations:**

**BL** - Back Loop only

**FL** - Front Loop only

( ex.: **BLDC** – DC in Back Loop only)

**3 DC** = [DC, DC, DC] in one stitch

**DC 3** = DC, DC, DC ( in 3 stitches, one in one)

### **Materials and tools needed:**

- Crochet thread size 3 or Super Fine weight yarn (#1)
- Crochet hook from 3 to 3.5 mm (depending on how tight or loose do you crochet)
- Tapestry Needle

Thread usage

Flower: 44 " (112 cm) for 3 flowers: 132 " (336 cm)

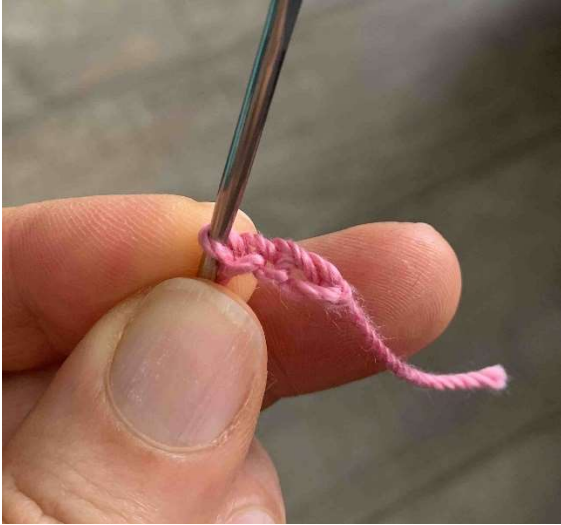
Stamens yellow yarn 20 " (51 cm)

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### **FLOWER.**

CH 3, join in a ring with a Sl St (or create Magic ring)

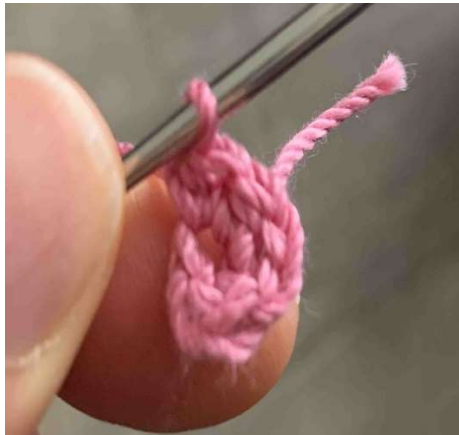
CH 2,[HDC 2 in the ring, Sl St in the ring]. Repeat [ ] 4 more times for 5 petals total. Fast off, tie the yarn in the back of the flower.



CH 3



Join in a ring with a SI St



First petal: CH 2, HDC 2, SI St in the ring.



Second petal



Back and Front of the flower.

**STEM.**

CH 10, SI St in the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the hook stitch, SI St 2,



CH 10, SI St in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st, SI St 4



CH 4, SI St in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st, SI St 3, SI St 10 (till the end )

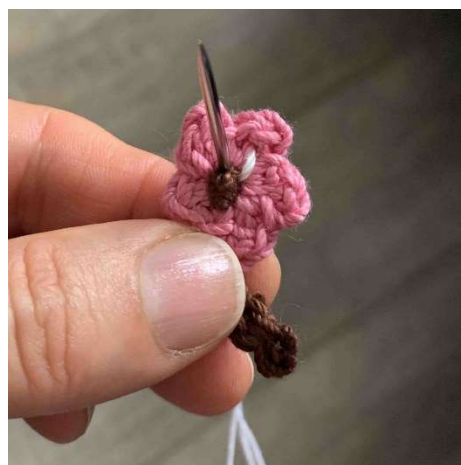




CH 3, Sl St in the beginning of the stem to create a loop for the earring hook or lanyard to attach.
