

Materials and tools needed:


- Crochet thread size 3 or Super Fine weight yarn (#1)
- Crochet hook from 3 to 3.5 mm (depending on how tight or loose do you crochet
- Tapestry Needle

Thread usage Flower: 44 " (112 cm) for 3 flowers: 132 " (336 cm) Stamens yellow yarn 20 " (51 cm)


FLOWER.

CH 3, join in a ring with a SI St (or create Magic ring)

CH 2,[HDC 2 in the ring, SI St in the ring]. Repeat [] 4 more times for 5 petals total. Fast off, tie the yarn in the back of the flower.




Join in a ring with a SI St



First petal: CH 2, HDC 2, SI St in the ring.

CH 3



Second petal



Back and Front of the flower.

<u>STEM</u>.

CH 10, SI St in the 2nd from the hook stitch, SI St 2,



CH 10, SI St in the 2nd st, SI St 4



CH 4, SI St in the 2^{nd} st, SI St 3, SI St 10 (till the end)





CH 3, SI St in the beginning of the stem to create a loop for the earring hook or lanyard to attach.
