**Skills: Beginner to intermediate**

## **Materials needed:**

Yarn ( I used Medium weight #3 (3 ply)

Crochet hook 4.0 – 4.5 mm

## **Stitches and abbreviations used: (US terms)**

Ch – chain stitch      Sl St – Slip stitch

SC – Single Crochet stitch    DC – Double crochet stitch    TC – Treble crochet stitch

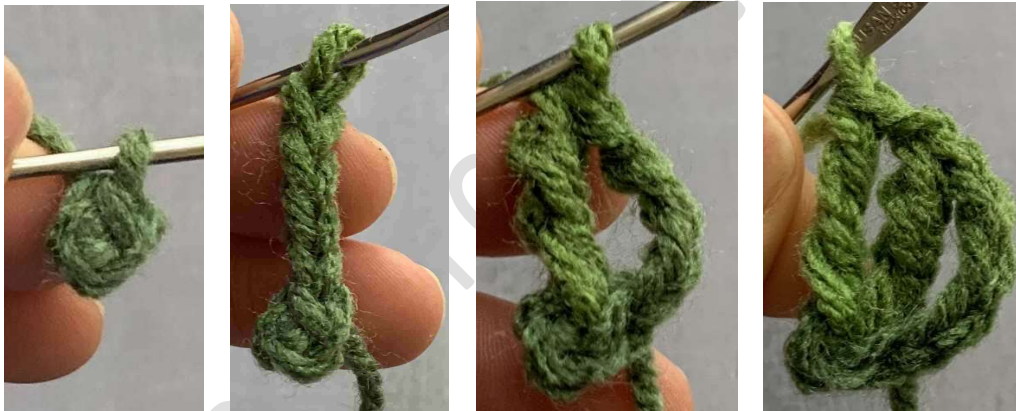
INC = increase (2 stitches in the place of one)

## LEAVES.



Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St (or create a magic ring)

Right side of the leaf: Ch 4, (DC in the ring, Ch 1) x 4

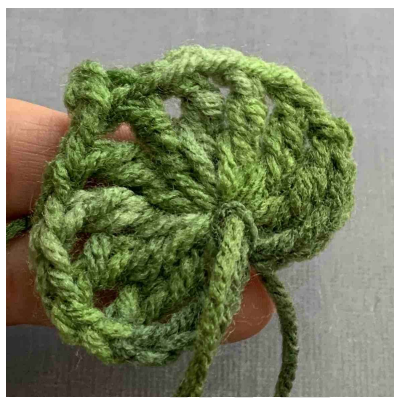


Center of the leaf: DC, Ch 1. Sl St in the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the hook stitch, (Picot, to create a pointed tip).





Left side of the leaf: (Ch 1, DC) x 4, Ch 4, Sl St in the ring. The leaf is ready!



Create a variety of leaves:

*\*For a smaller leaf use HDC stitches instead of DC stitches*

*\*For a bigger leaf use TC stitches instead of DC stitches*

## FLOWERS.



The center: Ch 4, join in a ring with a Sl St (or create a magic ring)

Ch 1, SC 9 in the ring, Sl St Total = 9 stitches



Petal1: CH 3, TC 6 stitch 1, TC 6 in the stitch 2, Ch 3, Sl St in the stitch 3







Petal 2: continue: TC 6 in the stitch 4, TC 6 in the stitch 5, Ch 3, Sl St in the stitch 6



Petal 3: continue: TC in the stitch 7, TC in the stitch 8, Ch 3, Sl St in the stitch 9.

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## BUDS.



Center: Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St (or create a magic ring)



Petals: Ch 2, DC INC x 6, Sl St (Total = 12 stitches)
