Crochet Patterns and Tutorials from

JTEasyCrochet And CrochetTanya FLOWER DOILY IN A VASE.



Skills Level: Beginner to Intermediate

Stitches used: (US terms)

Ch – chain SC – single crochet stitch

DC - double crochet stitch Sl St - slip stitch

TC - triple crochet stitch (yarn over 2 times)

DTR - double triple stitch (yarn over 3 times)

Materials and tools needed:

- Medium to worsted weight yarn (# 4)
- Crochet hook 5.0 mm

GREEN BODY OF THE DOILY.

Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St (or create a magic loop)

Row 1. Ch 3 (equals to DC + Ch 1), DC . [Ch 1, DC] 9 more times, Ch 1, Sl St.



Row 2: Sl St in the nearest space, Ch 3, DC in the same space, Ch 1 [[DC, Ch 1, DC] in each space, Ch 1] x 9 times, Sl St





Row 3: Sl St in the nearest "V" space (in DC, Ch 1, DC). Ch 2, DTR, DC, Ch 2. In every remaining "V" (9 times): DC, DTR, DC, Ch 2 to the next "V".









PETALS:

Petals are made in the spaces, formed by Ch 2's of the previous row. First petal: Ch 2 (equals to DC), DC, TC 2, DC 2, SC around the DTR of the previous row (Back post SC)

Other 9 petals: [DC 2, TC 2, DC 2, BP SC]







VASE.

Use 2 strands of medium weight yarn, and the same (5.00 mm / H-8 crochet hook). Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St or create a mafgic loop

Row 1: Ch 1, SC 6 in the ring, Sl St **Row 2:** Ch 1, [SC INC] x 6, Sl St

Row 3: Ch 1, [SC, SC INC] x 6, Sl St



Row 4: In the back loops: Ch 1, BL SC all around the row (18), Sl St





Rows 5-6: Ch 1, SC all around (18 stitches), Sl St



Row 7: SI St all around, tight.



Fold the Doily in half, then roll it and insert in vase. Ready! 😊
