CROCHET DAISY LACE.



Skills Level: Beginner

Stitches used: (US terms)

Ch – chain SC – single crochet stitch

TC – treble crochet stitch Sl St – slip stitch

Materials and tools needed:

- Crochet thread #10
 - Crochet hook 1.5 mm

The lace is made of separate flower motives joined together, as you make the last row. One motif is approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.5 cm) in diameter if you use recommended thread and hook (but you can use any thread and even yarn, with recommended crochet hook).

FLOWER MOTIF.

The center.

Ch 4, join in a ring with a Sl St

Ch 1, SC 12 in the ring, Sl St



The petals:

Petal = TC 3 tog (for the first petal make [Ch 3 (equals TC), TC 2] tog)

Ch 3 between the petals.

Make 12 petals and 12 "Ch 3'/s between the petals. Finish with the Sl St.



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
1st row of loops:

Sl St in the closest loop. Ch 6, [SC in the next loop, Ch 5] x 12, finish with a Sl St in the 1^{st} Ch of the first Ch 6.



2nd row of loops:

Sl St 2 or 3 to get to the top of the nearest loop of the previous row. Ch 7, [SC in the next loop, Ch 6] x 12, Sl St in the 1^{st} Ch of the first Ch 7.





Motif is ready!

JOINING THE MOTIVES.

Each motif is connected with another motif (the previous one/ones) with 3 loops, while making 2nd row of loops.

How to connect: Instead of making Ch 6 for the loop of the current motif , make Ch 3, Sl St in the other motif' loop, Ch 3, SC in the next loop of the current motif. Connect all 3 loops, then finish the 2nd row of loops of motif.
