VASE OF ROSES WITH SECRET STORAGE.



Skills Level: Beginner Intermediate

Stitches used: (US terms)

Ch – chain SC – single crochet stitch

DC – double crochet stitch Sl St – slip stitch

BL – Back Loop FL – Front Loop

Materials needed:

Yarn Worsted weight (#4) and crochet hook recommended for your yarn.

I used Red Heart Super Saver Solids and crochet hook H-8 (5.00 mm)

Stuffing

Yarn Needle (with wide eye)

VASE.

Use 2 strands of yarn and H-8 / 5.00 mm crochet hook – the vase should be stiff to keep it's shape.

Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St

Row 1: Ch 1, SC 6 in the ring, Sl St, total = 6 stitches

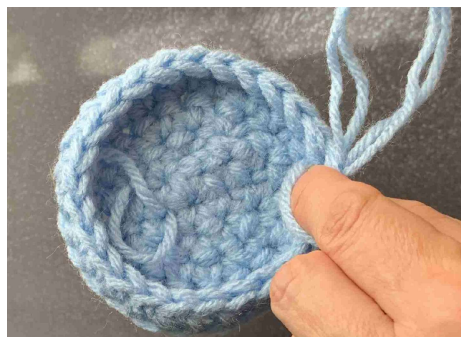
Row 2: Ch 1, SC INC x 6, Sl St, total = 12 stitches

Row 3: Ch 1, [SC, SC INC] x 6, Sl St, total = 18 stitches

Row 4: Ch 1, [SC 2, SC INC] x 6, Sl St, total = 24 stitches



Row 5: Ch 1, BL SC all around (24 st), Sl St



Rows 6-12: Ch 1, SC all around the row (24 sts) , Sl St (7 rows)



Row 13: Ch 1, [SC, SC INC] all around, Sl St, Fast off.



Bottom: Use remaining loops (front loops) of Row 5:

Attach the 2 strands of yarn and make a row of l At all around. Fast off.



THE BOW.

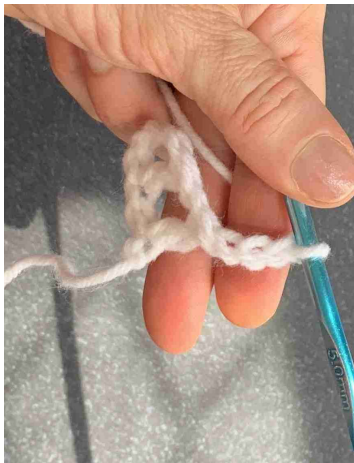
Use one strand of white yarn.

Ch 7,

Row 1: DC in the 5th stitch, Ch 1, DC in the 2nd stitch (that is the last stitch):



Row 2: Turn, Ch 3, DC in the DC of the previous row, Ch 1, DC in the DC of the previous row.



Repeat Row 2 for 32 times. The ribbon is ready!

(it should nbe about 22 “ (56 cm) long.



How to tie the bow:

Wrap the ribbon around the vase and tie the ends with the piece of white yarn:



Fold both ends in half to the back and tie again with another piece of yarn:



BALL OF ROSES:

Green yarn, 2 strands together:

Ch 3, join in a ring with a Sl St

Row 1: Ch 1, SC 6 in the ring, Sl St, total = 6 stitches

Row 2: Ch 1, SC INC x 6, Sl St, total = 12 stitches

Row 3: Ch 1, [SC, SC INC] x 6, Sl St, total = 18 stitches

Row 4: Ch 1, [SC 2, SC INC] x 6, Sl St, total = 24 stitches

Row 5: Ch 1, [SC 3, SC INC] x 6, Sl St, total = 30 stitches



Rows 6-8: Ch 1, SC all around the row, Sl St



Row 9: Ch 1, [SC 3, SC DEC] x 6, Sl St

Row 10: Ch 1, [SC 2, SC DEC] x 6, Sl St

Row 11: Ch 1, [SC, SC DEC] x 6, Sl St

Row 12: Ch 1, SC DEC x 6, Sl St

Fast off, stuff the ball lightly and close the hole.



Make 14 Roses.

Sewing the Roses on.

Sew one center Rose to the top,



Sew the first row of Roses around the center Rose, 6 roses total:



Sew on the second row of Roses around the First row of Roses, 7 Roses total:



The Vase of Roses is ready! 😊
