**VICTORIAN ROSE BLANKET.**



Skills Level: Beginner

**Stitches used: (US terms)**

**Ch – chain            SC – single crochet stitch**

**DC – double crochet stitch    Sl St – slip stitch**

**TC – triple crochet stitch (yarn over 2 times)**

**FP DC – Front Post Double Crochet**

**Materials and tools needed:**

- Soft Medium weight yarn (# 3), I used Baby Soft Lions Brand White for the body of the blanket – 1 ½ skein

Dusty Green for the Leaf Border - 1/3 skein

Dusty Pink, Petals and Cream for the Roses (just a bit, 1/5 – 1/4 of a skein)

(1 skein = 5 oz/140 g; 459 yd/420 m)

- Crochet hook 4.0 mm - 4.5 mm
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## **THE BODY OF THE BLANKET.**

*NOTE: I will be using a small square sample for this tutorial, but you can make the blanket as big as you need 😊*

White yarn.

Make a Chain, as long as you need for the blanket, the number of stitches should be 3 x (...) + 2.

**Row 1:** DC in the 4<sup>th</sup> stitch, DC all along.



**Row 2:** Turn, Ch 2, DC, [FP DC , DC 2] till the end of the row, DC in the last stitch.



**Row 3:** Turn, Ch 2, DC, [FP DC 2, DC] along the row

(Make sure that in that row FP DC stitches are made in DC stitches pf the previous row and DC stitches are made in FP DC stitches pf the previous row, i.e in reverse)



This is **Row 3** from the back:



This is **Row 3** from the front:



Continue making rows like Row 2 and Row 3 till you have the size you need.

Even rows: (2, 4, 6 etc): Turn, Ch 2, DC, [FP DC, DC 2] all along, DC

Odd rows: (3, 5, 7 etc): Turn, Ch 2, [FP DC 2, DC] all along



## **LEAF BORDER.**

**Border Row 1:** Continue with white yarn. Ch 2, make a row of DC stitches all around the blanket (DC 3 in the corner stitch for each corner), finish with a Sl St. Fast off white yarn.





**Border Row 2:** Attach Green yarn.

Ch 1, SC all around the blabket ( SC 3 in the corner sitches), Sl St at the end.



**Border Row 3:** The leaves. (each leaf is a modified shell stitch).

[TC in the 3<sup>rd</sup> stitch, Ch 2, TC, Ch 2, TC, (Picot: Ch 1, Sl St), Ch 2, TC, Ch 2, TC, SC in the 3<sup>rd</sup> stitch].

Make [ ] all around.

Note: If needed – adjust a number of skipped stitches (+ 1 or -1) for the 2-3 previous shell so that each corner is between the shells.

Finish with a Sl St.



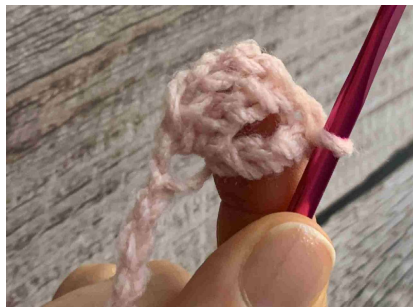




**SWIRLY ROSE.**

Ch 25.

TC INC ( 2 TC) in the 5<sup>th</sup> stitch.



[ TC INC ] x 10

[HDC INC, HDC] x 5



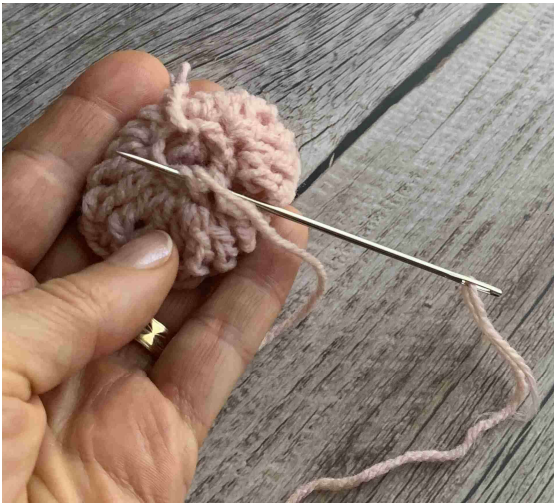
Cut off the yarn leaving about 10-12 “ (25-28 cm) yarn end.



Wrap it around the finger to form a flower



Secure the flower from unraveling with stitches on the back:



Ready! 😊

Make as many roses as you want and sew them to the blanket:



Victorian Rose Blanket is ready! 😊
