THE PRAYER OF HUMBLE ACCESS

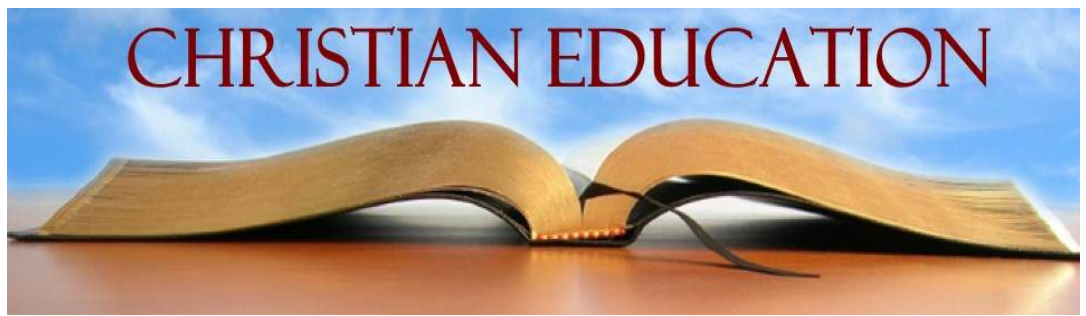

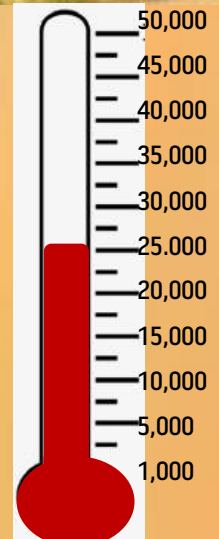
