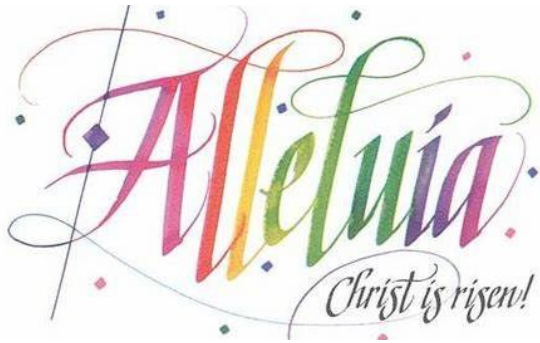

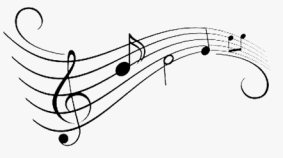

The Season of *Eastertide*



Eastertide cover a fifty day period (6) Sunday that challenges persons to reflect on the resurrection of Jesus. Ascension Day is celebrated the sixth Thursday after Easter and commemorates the last manifestation of Jesus to his followers after the resurrection. Ascension Sunday is the Sunday following Ascension Day. The season ends with the day of Pentecost. White is the appropriate color for the season, with gold as an accent color.

There are many symbols for this significant celebration. They hold meanings that enhance the celebration and express the root of Christian belief that believers will eventually be raised from the dead and enjoy eternal life. The symbol for Lent and Easter are different. Whereas the major symbols for Lent represent the agony, suffering, and pain that Jesus endured; the symbols of Easter represent new birth and renewal. Most of the symbols represent something that was dead or dormant but births forth into new life and growth.

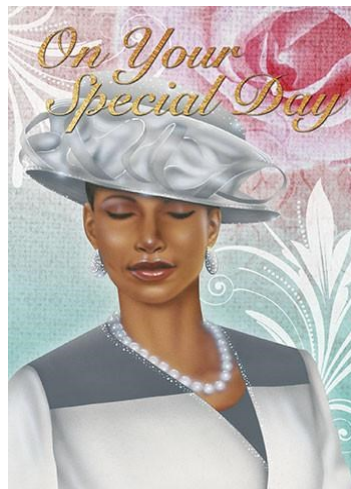

The Inspiration of Emma Clarissa Clement on Mother's Day.

On Mother's Day in 1946, the American Mothers organization gave **Emma Clarissa Clement** its "Mother of the Year" honor, the first Black woman to receive the award.

Clement, the granddaughter of an escaped slave, lived in Providence, Rhode Island and came south to attend Livingstone College in Salisbury, North Carolina, where she married Rev. George Clinton Clement on May 25, 1898. Clement, 71, when she received the award, had accomplished much as a mother, civic leader and religious educator in the state of Kentucky. As a widow, she raised four sons and three daughters, four of whom went on to become college professors. All seven of the Clement children graduated from Livingstone College, the chief institution of higher learning in the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church. Upon

winning the award, Clement accepted the honor on behalf of all Black mothers. She continued working in the state for the A.M.E. Zion church until her passing in 1952. The American Mothers organization is an offshoot of the Golden Rule Foundation, founded by Eleanor Roosevelt, Sara Delano Roosevelt, Mamie Eisenhower, JC Penney, and Norman Vincent Peale. The organization recognizes mothers from all walks of life who have used the role to provide inspiration and instruction to the nation's future.

THE 'C' (2.0 – 2.9 GPA) SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must have a **2.0-2.9 GPA (C)** and must show satisfactory academic progress.
2. Applicant must be in the graduating year of high school and have been accepted into a school of higher education for the following semester/quarter.
3. Applicant must submit a photo (approximately **3" by 5"** with application. (Photo is not returnable); by submitting, student agrees that photo may be used for publication (if an award is granted).
4. Applicant must submit an **official high school transcript and a copy of a college/university letter of acceptance with the application.**
5. Applicant must submit a completed **typed** application (if handwritten, it must be printed). **Application must be complete in every detail with required information and signatures affixed. Format and text cannot be altered.**
6. **TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATIONS** (ONE FROM A PERSON OF CHOICE OR CHAPTER AND ONE FROM AN ACADEMIC PROFESSOR, INSTRUCTOR OR TEACHER)
7. **Application must be received by June 30, 2024. Email or Priority Mail ! NO EXCEPTIONS.**

AWARD RECIPIENTS:

1. Recipient must enroll in school on a full-time basis during the academic year or will forfeit the award for non-enrollment.
2. Recipient must use awards to pursue a course of study leading to a degree in any accredited university, college, or junior college in the United States.
3. A recipient who withdraws during the academic year and does not transfer to another institution will forfeit the unused portion of the award.
4. Recipient must forward to the foundation an official grade report at the end of each semester/quarter. Failure to do so may forfeit the unused portion of the award.
