The Season Of ***PENTECOST***



Pentecost is the birthday of the Christian Church and reveals the descent or outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the believers in the Upper Room. Pentecost is sometimes referred to as Whitsunday referring either to the wearing of white robes by candidates for baptism or to the old Anglo-Saxon word “wit” meaning wisdom—an allusion to the outpouring of the Spirit of Wisdom. To the Christian, *Pentecost* means the Church’s birthday that is celebrated on the fiftieth day after Easter. Acts 2 gives the record of the day when the Holy Spirit came upon the Disciples and they began to speak in tongues preaching Christ as the risen Lord. Three thousand persons were baptized into the Christian faith at that time.

The day of Pentecost also occurs fifty days after the Passover. In the Jewish faith, this is the Feast of Weeks that commemorates the day on which Moses received the law on top of Mount Sinai. Tradition states that the early Christians observed Pentecost by shooting fire from the roof of the church to represent “the tongues of fire” that rested on the Disciples. Often this was not practical, so doves were collected and released during the worship service.

The **liturgical color** is red which is symbolic of the Holy Spirit, witness, zeal, power, loyalty and love. Prominent symbols include **cloven tongues of fire**, the **descending dove**, and a downward arrow. The Christian Church is often represented by using a ship or a rainbow (denotes the fulfillment of a promise). As Pentecost is celebrated, one should reflect on the coming of the Comforter (Holy Spirit) to the Disciples, and the power and miracles that resulted due to this coming, plus the need to allow the spirit to embody and empower persons today.

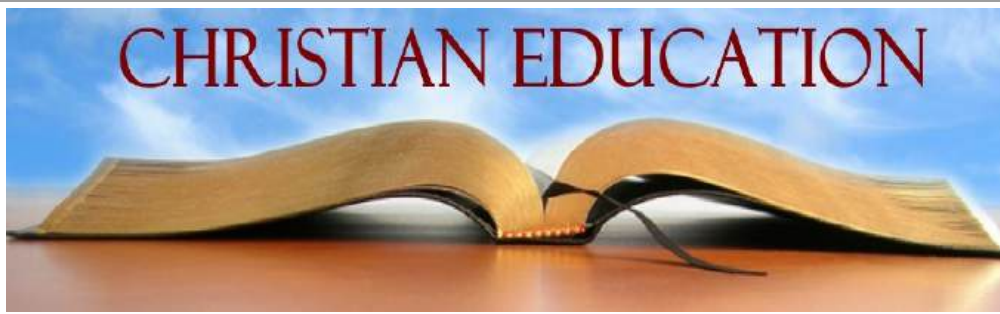

Dear Members of Little Rock:

I. Overview:

As I shared at the first Members Meeting held on December 19, 2024, the church will move to a monthly asking from our adult members.

The goals are as follows:

- Pay off the mortgage
- Create a constant cash flow
- Pay for church renovations and property maintenance.

II. Cost:

The Board of Stewards and Trustees is projecting the cost of all the annual expenses to cover the mortgage, renovations, and church expenses is

\$609,000.00

□ Through **prayer, supplication, and pledges**, the Board of Trustees firmly believes that we, the members of Little Rock, can **and** will be able to raise the additional \$609,000.00 that is needed – *“And this is the confidence that we have in **him**, that, if we ask anything according to **his** will, he heareth us!”*

III. How can we do this:

We can achieve our goal of \$609,000.00 in this way

The members participate in a Financial Tier Pledge System, based upon a member’s current financial situation.

IV. Financial Tier Pledge System:

Here at Little Rock, we have approximately 400 paying members.

□ **Platinum Pledge:**

□ We need **50** Members to Pledge \$2,700 or \$225/Month, this would raise: \$135,000

□ **Gold Pledge:**

□ We need **100** Members to Pledge \$2,100 or \$175/Month, this would raise: \$210,000

□ **Silver Pledge:**

□ We need **130** Members to Pledge \$1,200 or \$100/Month, this would raise: \$156,000

□ **Bronze Pledge:**

□ We need **120** Members to Pledge \$900 or \$75/Month, this would raise: \$108,000

TOTAL PLEDGES RAISED \$609,000.00

V. Other:

It is very important to remember that if you choose a Pledge Amount, that the Church **still needs your commitment to your regular weekly/monthly tithes**, so that we can continue to pay our monthly expenses.
