# The Season

## *Kingdomtide*



Kingdomtide begins on the last Sunday in August and continues until the beginning of Advent, which starts on the fourth Sunday before Christmas. During this period, special emphasis is placed on the Kingship of the Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. The observance is wrapped up in the heightened awareness of one of the basic tenets of the Christian Faith—the hope of the coming of the Kingdom of Heaven.

“Kingdomtide represents the ongoing of the Spirit released on the Day of Pentecost that is continuing to change and empower persons.” The liturgical colors for Kingdomtide are **Green** and **Gold**. The Green is symbolic of the freshness of nature, hope, life and growth. The Gold is used for the lettering. The **Fringe** denotes worth, virtue, glory to God and Christian might. The Kingship of the Christ Child and the price Jesus paid on Calvary is also represented in the Gold color.

The **CROWN** and **SCEPTER** designate royalty, social, political or religious status. They represent Jesus as King, Ruler and Lord of all. The crown also symbolizes the final reward for believers who have been faithful to GOD.



## REV. SAMUEL C. BLANKS

### Pastor of Metropolitan A.M.E. Zion Church, Hartford, Connecticut

The Reverend Samuel Corey Blanks is a native of Bladenboro, NC. He is the second of two children born to the late Mr. James Albert Blanks and Mrs. Janice Cynthia Blue Blanks. He completed his primary education in the Bladenboro public [school](#) system; further studies were done at Livingstone College and Fayetteville [State University](#). He was always a bright and intuitive child and was especially interested in hearing the word being brought forth by the pastor of his hometown church every Sunday. It was no [surprise](#) to his parents when he accepted the call to ministry at the tender age of 15 and received his first appointment to pastor New Zion A.M.E. Zion church in Lisbon, NC at 17 years old. Since then, he has held pastorates at Shady Grove AME Zion Church, and Rehobeth A.M.E. Zion Church, all in the Cape Fear Annual Conference. Reverend Blanks decided to take a leap of faith that brought him to the West Central North Carolina Conference where he was assigned to pastor the Rock Hill AME Zion Church in Concord NC. Reverend Blanks also pastored the St. Stephen Metropolitan A.M.E. Zion Church in High Point, NC and then transferred to the New England Annual Conference in June 2019 where they served as the Pastor and first family at Spottswood A.M.E. Zion Church in New Britain, CT. In February 2023, to his current assignment as the Pastor of The Metropolitan A.M.E. Zion Church in Hartford, CT.

Currently Rev. Blanks serves as a District and Conference Instructor for the Hartford District and New England Annual Conference. He also serves as the Chairman of Budget and Finance Committee for the Hartford District. He is Chairman of Board of Christian Education and serves on the Board of Trustees for the New England Annual Conference. He is also a member of the Harriet Tubman Board of Directors for the Northeastern Episcopal District.

He promotes Zion's customs and culture and is often referred to as an "old soul" because of his love of old hymns, his favorite being 'It Is Well with My Soul'.

His commitment to service extends beyond the church doors as he has held several civic and political positions between his appointments. He believes the church is not just a place of worship, but its leaders and congregation have a duty to promote healing, love, and kindness for all, regardless of race, religion, or color. He believes in partnering with various religious entities to help foster peace and love. This is truly his commitment to ministry, and he stays the course.

Many blessings have been bestowed upon him due to his commitment to spreading the word of God and remaining a humble servant. He is a proud member of the Hartford Chapter of Delta Pi Sigma Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.

The Reverend Samuel C. Blanks and his wife Mrs. Nicole Ann Blanks were assigned to the New England Conference in June 2019,

Rev. and Sis. Blanks currently reside in Hartford, along with their two children, daughter Korie Makenzie Blanks who was born in April 2018, and son Theodore Andrew Blanks born in December 2019.


