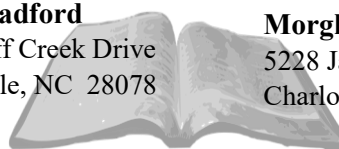

Requirements

Be a current member of the Assembly of Christian Educators (upload a confirmation email/letter from your ACE Regional Vice President or purchase receipt at the appropriate point in the application). Provide a copy of your resume or curriculum vitae (upload in PDF format at the appropriate point in the application). Provide a copy of your **official transcript** (upload in PDF format at the appropriate point in the application). College freshman must submit high school transcript. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 as reflected in your official transcript (if applicable).

Provide two letters of recommendation:

Christian Educator Reference - Bishop, Presiding Elder, Pastor, Sunday School Teacher, Episcopal, Conference, District, or Local Director of Christian Education, etc. Must be someone associated with The A.M.E. Zion Church.

Professional/Community Reference - Community Leader, Professor, Teacher, Dean, Supervisor, Manager, Politician, Mentor, etc. Must be someone that is NOT associated with The A.M.E. Zion Church.

Submit a photo of yourself; must be a clear headshot.

Are You A Registered Voter? Deadline

October 9, 2020

Qualifications to Vote: 1) you must be a citizen of the United States; (2) you must be at least 18 years of age, or you will be 18 years of age by the next general election and you are voting in the primary, or you must be between the ages of 16 or 17 and desire to preregister to vote; (3) you must have resided in North Carolina and in the precinct in which you are to vote for at least 30 days prior to the election and (4) you must not be currently serving a felony sentence. Registration forms are located in the hall of the Education Wing at the Church.



Key Dates For Mecklenburg County Voters

October 9— Regular voter registration deadline

October 15— Early voting begins at 32 throughout Mecklenburg County. Sites will be listed in bulletin.

October 27— Last day you can send in an absentee request form and still get an absentee ballot. (Tip: **DO IT LONG BEFORE THIS DAY.**)

October 31— Last day of early voting

November 3— Election Day

Absentee info

To request an absentee ballot from the Board of Elections you can still mail in a request form. The North Carolina Board of Elections opened an Absentee Ballot Portal on its website.

After you send your ballot: You can now track your ballot, much like you do a package, through the state board of election's new ballotrax tool. You can also still check with the local board of elections.

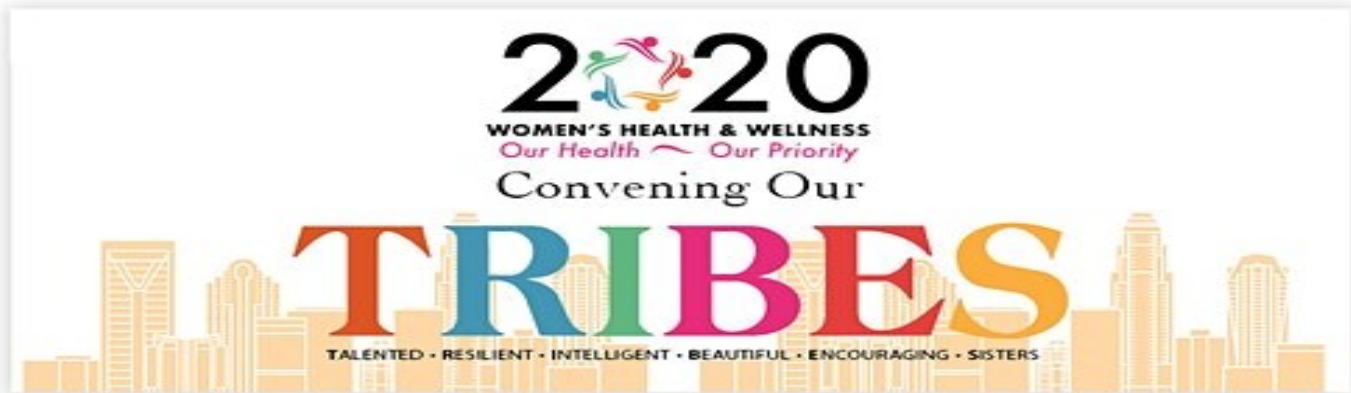

tion to rally behind God's intention that all Christians—children, youth and adults grow and learn; a day for congregations to celebrate their ministry of Christian education life and mission of our church.

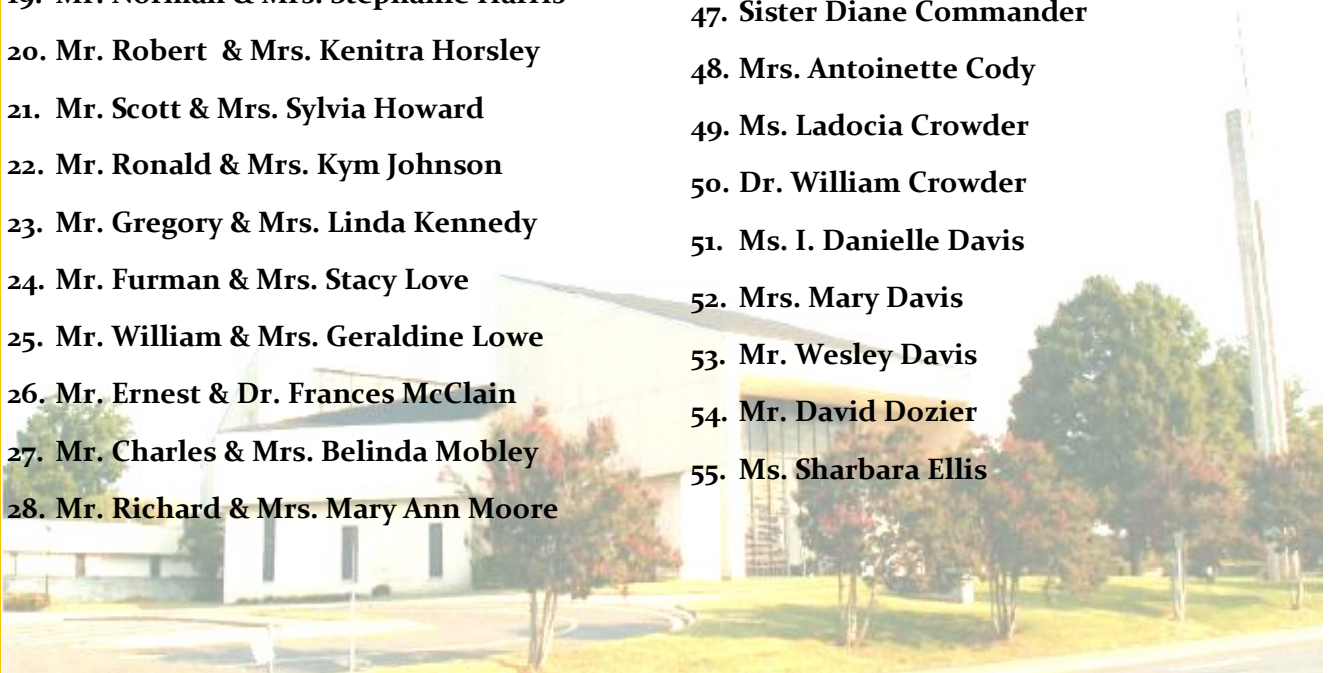

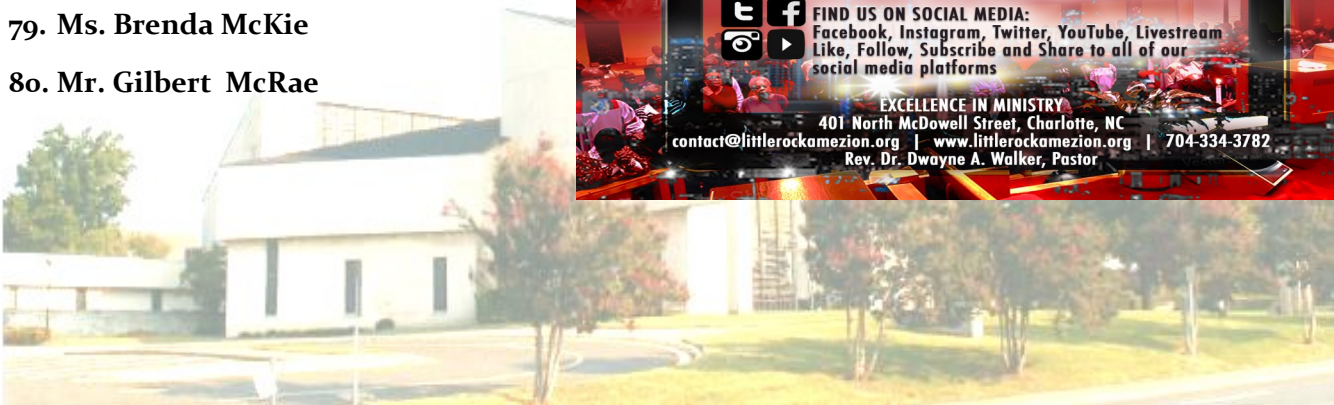
