

Qualifications to Vote: 1) you must be a citizen of the United States; (2) you must be at least **REGISTER** 18 years of age, or you will be 18 years of age by the next general election and you are voting in the

primary, or you must be between the ages of 16 or 17 and desire to preregister to vote; (3) you must have resided in North Carolina and in the precinct in which you are to vote for at least 30 days prior to the election and (4) you must not be currently serving a felony sentence. 
