

Our comprehensive, preventative medical clinics, which benefit employees, spouses, and dependents, fall into three categories:

- On-site Clinics: These are located at the company's worksite and offer maximum convenience.
- Near-site Clinics: These are located near a single employer with a decentralized workforce where most employees may not operate under the same roofline.
- Collaborative Clinics: This option is a shared resource among multiple employers when one may not have a large enough workforce to sustain its own clinic, or an anchor company wishes to draw smaller businesses together for the shared vision of better health in a community.



"I've always loved to work in a setting where I can connect with patients. I can be that resource for questions at all illness and health stages," she said.


Rachel, who has a doctoral degree in nursing practice, has worked for 20 years in operating rooms, intensive care units, and recovery rooms. She has also worked in urgent care clinics. Clinics are often problem-focused, making it challenging to provide comprehensive care in a frenzied environment.

"I would see patients and treat their immediate needs, but I knew they had other problems that were being neglected."

People may associate nurse burnout with long hours, but that's not always the cause, said Debra Iverson, a family nurse practitioner with a long career in healthcare.

An expert in diabetes, Debra worked at a medical clinic several years ago, where she was allowed only 15 minutes to treat each patient's multiple and complicated medical conditions. She struggled to review complex medication regimens, evaluate blood sugar levels, discuss her patients' diets, examine their feet, and investigate related issues.

"At Cor Medical, because there are so few administrative barriers, we can immediately get them the care they need."

"There was never enough time. I felt horrible and defeated. I knew I wasn't doing enough, and I knew my patients might not improve. I went home knowing I had spent 8-10 hours working so hard, and thinking maybe I had done something good, but maybe not," she said. "I spent five years at that clinic, and it was the first time in my life I experienced clinical depression."

At Cor Medical, her job is a stark contrast to her previous healthcare experiences. Why? She practices medicine in a way that aligns with her nursing philosophy: taking time to care for each patient's immediate needs and discovering new ones, all of which help prevent disastrous health situations.

Our comprehensive approach to healthcare means we focus on emotional and physical wellness, prevention, detection, and chronic disease management. We save patients from catastrophic health events that result from undiagnosed health conditions, and we teach healthy, sustainable lifestyle modifications that create a more engaged workforce.

We manage diabetes—one of the most common and costly insurance claims—hypertension, asthma, thyroid disease, and many more chronic conditions. We treat acute conditions such as stomach viruses, and we regularly provide preventative screenings, lab work, flu shots, and vaccines. We also offer one of the nation's first treatment programs for Post-COVID-19 symptoms.

Our physical therapy services include injury rehabilitation, orthopedics, sports medicine, dry needling, and cupping. Our dietitian guides patients in managing nutrition, emotional eating, and diabetes.

Lastly, our mental health therapists help patients navigate anxiety, depression, grief, loss, work/life balance, and more. They also help patients cope with stressful or traumatic life events, such as the COVID-19 pandemic.

When primary care and preventative screenings are accessible and affordable, employees prioritize their wellness, making them healthier, happier, and more productive. Health becomes a habit.

Many employees choose to prioritize work and family obligations over their medical needs. Missing a business meeting to drive across town to a physician's office seems inconvenient, so the medical appointment for a seemingly minor issue never happens. Similarly, a working mother makes medical appointments for her entire family, omitting her own needs. When an on-site medical clinic is a brief walk from an employee's workstation, and a virtual appointment is a few clicks away, the employee learns to prioritize—and improve—her health.

Access to same-day appointments means fewer trips to emergency rooms and urgent care clinics and less time away from work. While our clinics have waiting rooms, patients rarely wait to be seen. And seasonal services like flu shots are often provided through drive-thru events, in which employees never leave their cars. We believe time should never be a barrier in healthcare.

Are you frustrated with healthcare's rising cost and your employees' declining health? We can improve your employees' emotional and physical health, reduce your company's medical expenditures, and help you improve employee retention and recruitment efforts. Who doesn't want to work for someone who values their well-being?

Cor Medical's cost-savings are easy to measure. Our integrated primary care model provides services at a lower cost than community pricing and reduces unnecessary emergency room visits. Our Cor Medical team has discovered that employees save an average of 75% by choosing their on-site clinic instead of walk-in clinics. And we are not alone in our discoveries. The nonprofit National Association of Worksite Health Centers surveyed 255 employers who implemented on-site and near-site clinics to control rising healthcare costs.

A majority of respondents reported:

- A 64% reduction in medical care costs
- An almost 70% reduction in time lost by employees leaving work to see outside medical providers
- A 63% reduction in ER visits


