FLEA TREATMENT PROTOCOL

The following guidelines need to be followed in order to alleviate your flea problem as quickly as possible. We appreciate your due diligence in adhering to these simple steps so we may achieve the results that we all want.

A. THE DAY BEFORE WE ARRIVE

- 1. Remove everything off all carpeted areas. All clothes, shoes, toys, pet items, items under the bed, items in the closet, etc. We can't treat thoroughly if the carpet is not fully exposed.
- 2. Vacuum the ENTIRE home, paying close attention to the baseboards, upholstery, drapes, and cushions. Vacuum under furniture as well.
 - 3. Throw away vacuum bag in dumpster or exterior garbage can. DO NOT leave bag inside.
 - 4. Wash all bed linens, pet bedding, and other infested items in HOT, soapy water.

B. THE DAY WE TREAT

- 1. All pets must be removed including dogs, cats, hamsters, birds, etc. Fish tanks need to be covered.
- 2. Dogs and cats need to be treated by a professional veterinarian for fleas as close as possible to the treatment date.
 - 3. The house must be vacated for 2-3 hours after treatment in order to allow the carpet to dry.
- 4. Before we leave, the air conditioning will be set at 65 degrees in order to help the drying process.

C. AFTER OUR TREATMENT

- 1. Do not vacuum for 1 week after treatment.
- 2. A follow up will be completed in 1-week. All protocols in section A need to be followed prior to the follow up. This may seem like a lot of work, but the fleas will remain if you do not complete this important step.
 - 3. Three days after follow up, thoroughly vacuum the home, and them dispose of the bag again.
