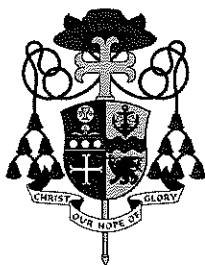

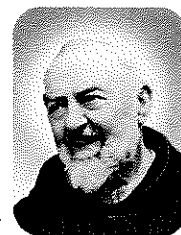

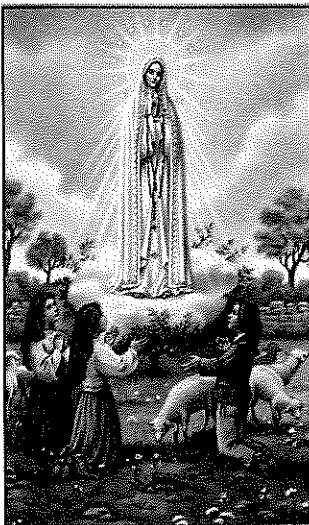

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah 35:4-7 This section of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet to God's people exiled in Babylon. He encourages them that one day they will be free to return home to Jerusalem. This journey will be through the desert, but God will transform this barren wasteland to ease their passing home.

James 2:1-5 The letter of James was written approximately 50 years after the death and resurrection of Jesus. It was addressed not to a particular community, but to Christians everywhere. Because of this, it is a part of a group of New Testament letters called *catholic epistles* – meaning that the author wrote them for all Christians. One of the trademarks of the epistle of James is the need to *act* on God's word, not just *listen* to it.

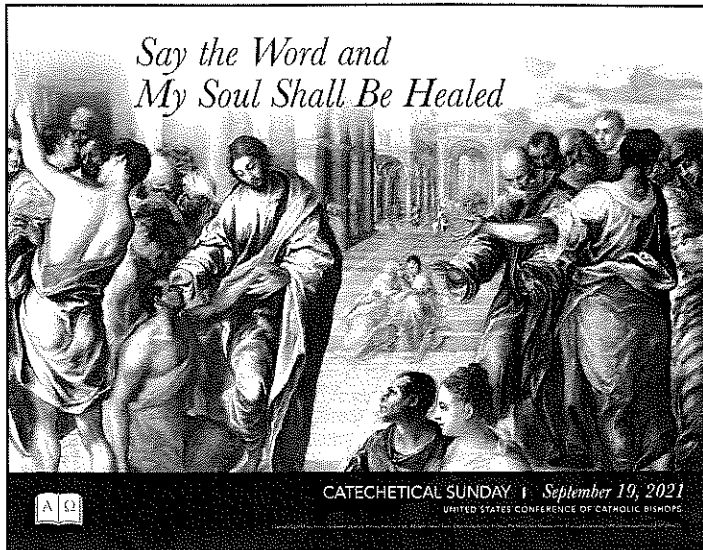

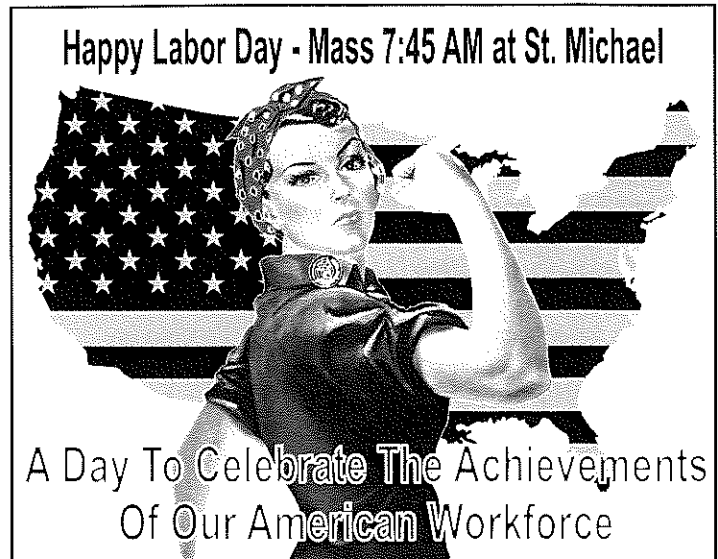
Catechetical Sunday

The United States Constitution stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans throughout history to maintain their liberties, freedoms and inalienable rights.

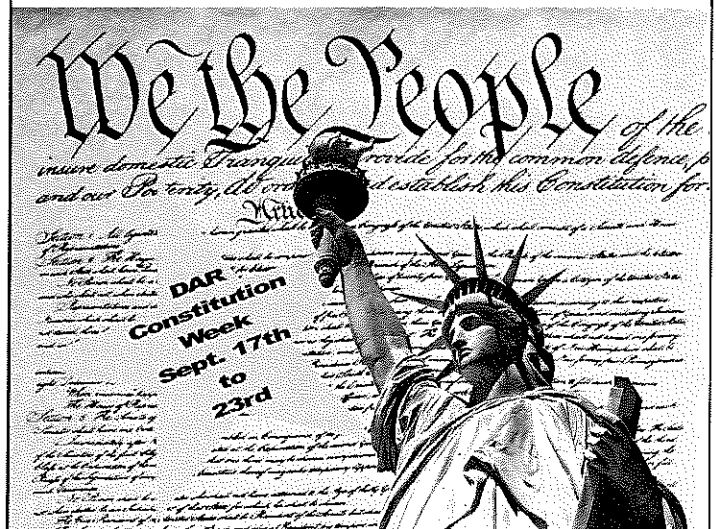

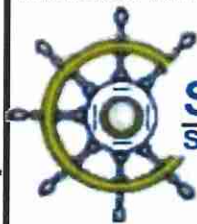
