INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Twenty-seventh
Sunday in Ordinary Time (Cycle C)

First Reading: Habakkuk 1:2-3, 2:2-4
The book of the prophet Habakkuk is one of the smaller books of the Bible.
He was a contemporary of Jeremiah, and preached at a time when Babylon (modern-day Iraq) threatened to destroy Jerusalem. Today's passage is a dialogue between the prophet and the Lord.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14
Although the author attributes the second letter to Timothy to St. Paul, it was probably written by someone else as much as 30 years after Paul's death. This was an acceptable practice at the time. One important theme of this letter is the need to be faithful to the Gospel and not to be swayed by false teachings.






