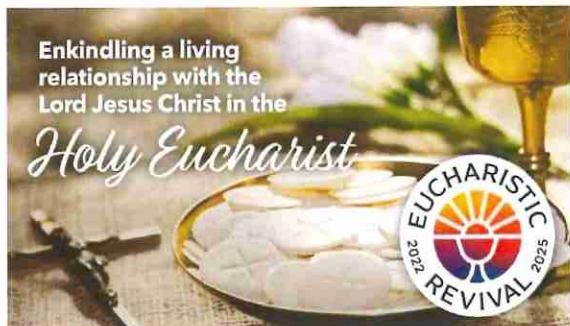

Dear Evangelizers for the Lord,

Preparations are underway for our final Eucharistic Revival Event, which is the closing Mass, celebrated on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 22, 2025, at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament. We have several prayer experiences leading up to the Eucharistic Celebration of the Mass at 5:00 p.m.

Accompanying this letter is an invitation letter from Bishop Mark to this sacred event and a flyer which we hope individuals will post in their parishes, to motivate parishioners around the diocese to attend this celebration not as an end to our focus on the Eucharistic but rather a celebration of how our eyes and hearts have been opened to the gift we have in the Eucharist as the real presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus. We hope we have become People on the Emmaus Journey, recognize his true presence each time the bread is broken, and the cup is shared.

The Letter from Bishop Mark and the flyer unfolds the invitation and the schedule for the day. A few points which I want to highlight and of which I hope will be placed in parish bulletins:

- Priests are invited to concelebrate, with the Deacons
- Bishop Mark extends an invitation to the **Knights of Columbus** and the **Catholic Daughters** with special seating to the right and left of the Cathedral reserved for them.
- **Extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist**, and **Altar Servers** dressed in their robes can be seated with their families and will receive a special Blessing from Bishop Mark for the Ministry they perform within the Eucharist.
- The **First Communicants of 2025** are invited to wear their First Communion Clothes. They can be seated with their families, and they too will receive a blessing from Bishop Mark.
- **Newly Confirmed** and **Young people in general** from across the diocese are invited by Bishop Mark to be seated throughout the Cathedral to show their support for the power of the Eucharist and to be empowered to carry on the Great Commission.

I look forward to seeing you during this powerful time and experience of being Eucharistic People.
