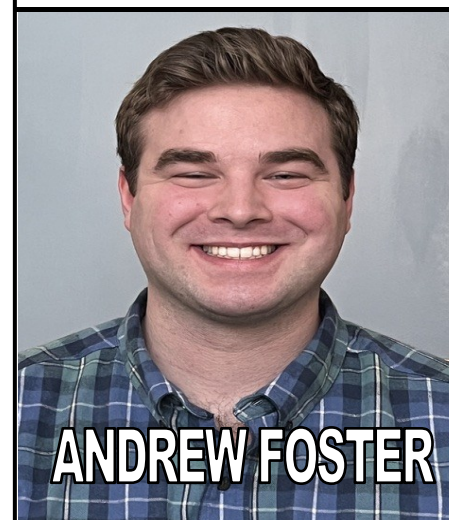
**Bishop Bartchak would like to remind us to prayerfully consider participating in our diocese's Vocation Appeal.**

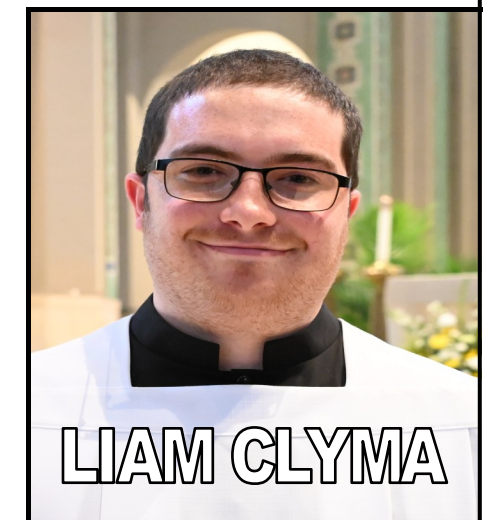
