

Holy Day of Obligation

Thursday, August 15th, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Catholics are obligated to participate at Mass on this day. The Church remembers that she who was immaculate from the moment of her conception because she was to bear the Eternal Word, did not die in the flesh but was assumed into heaven.

The east speaks of the "falling asleep" of the Mother of God. Decay could not touch the body of the one who bore the eternal Godhead, Jesus Christ. As Mary has gone, so all believers will have their body and soul reunited at the second coming of the Risen Christ. Come celebrate Mary's new life in the Lord's resurrection.

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Tin1e (Cycle B)

First Reading: 1 Kings 19:4-8

The prophet Elijah lived about 800 years before Christ. Because he was loyal to God, he fell into disfavor with King Ahab and Queen Jezebel. He had to flee for his life to Moun t Horeb (also known as Mount Sinai). Today's passage takes place as he begins his flight.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:30-5:2

As in the past four Sundays, our second Scripture reading is from the letter to the Ephesians. This part of the letter contains advice for Christian living. The author says that actions which cause division in a community are simply unacceptable. In today's reading, the author sees mutual forgiveness as essential for any group that calls itself Christian. There is an echo here of part of the Lord's prayer.

If oly Name Parish in Ebensburg will be the site of three presentations in late summer/early fall by three individuals:

Father David Michael Moses, a priest of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston, will be the guest speaker on Wednesday, September 4th at 7:00 PM.

Father David Michael is 30 years old and grew-up in Houston, Texas. He started college when he was just 14 and graduated with his bachelor's degree at the age of 18.

He was accepted into several law schools, but ultimately felt called to the priesthood and entered seminary for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston.

He was ordained in 2019 at the age of 25 and is now the parochial vicar at Christ the Good Shepherd in Spring, Texas.

He enjoys writing music and his "Concerts for Life" have collectively raised almost \$800,000 to assist women in crisis pregnancies.

Father David Michael is the founder of the Pilgrim Rosary project and is also active on social media, with a collective following of over 600,000, where he shares stories from priestly life.

On Monday and Tuesday, September 23rd and 24th, **Father Daniel Reehil**, a priest and exorcist from the Diocese of Nashville, Tennessee, will speak at Holy Name at 7:00 PM each night.
