INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

First Reading: Isaiah 50: 4-7 Chapters 40-55 of the book of Isaiah contains the message of a prophet who spoke to God's people during their exile in Babylon. Several times the prophet speaks about a Servant who will one day deliver God's people. Because the Servant is portrayed as suffering, Christians have traditionally identified Jesus with him.

Second Reading: Philippians 2: 6-11 In the years following Christ's death and resurrection, Christians began to develop the prayers and hymns that would become part of their rituals. In today's passage from the letter to the Philippians, Paul appears to be quoting an early Christian hymn celebrating the dying and rising of Christ.

THE BLESSING OF EASTER FOOD BASKETS

Easter Food Baskets will be blessed at
St. Mary Church on Holy Saturday at 11:00 AM.

People with Eastern European backgrounds: Poland, Russia, Serbia, Slovenia, Hungary, Ukraine, the Balkans and other countries with Slavic tradition -might be familiar with the blessing of Easter foods. What's in the baskets depends on the region one is from and the family's preferences. The food in the Easter baskets, like the food served during the Jewish Passover, would also carry significant religious symbolism.

- **Bread:** symbolizes Christ the Bread of Life. Easter bread is sometimes sweetened, braided, or even decorated with a dough cross.
- **Butter:** a symbol of God's goodness and the richness of salvation. Sometimes it is molded into the shape of a lamb. Cheese would have similar symbolism.
- **Eggs:** a symbol of life, hope, rebirth, and resurrection.
- **Horseradish:** symbolic of the bitterness and harshness of Christ's passion. It is sometimes mixed with grated beets.
- **Meat (ham, lamb, smoked sausage):** symbolize God's favor and generosity. Since pork was forbidden in the Old Testament, eating it now symbolizes that all things are made new in Christ. Linked sausage can remind us that Christ broke the chains of death and rose triumphant.
- **Salt:** to symbolize preservation and purification. It also reminds us the we are to be "the salt of the earth."
- **Wine:** to gladden the heart.
- **Candy and baked sweets:** symbolize God's providential sustenance, life's sweetness, eternal life, and the good things to come in the heavenly banquet.
- **Candle:** reminds us that Christ is our light. It may also be used at the Easter table.
- **White cloth-used either under or over the food:** symbolizes the burial cloth of Jesus that was found left in the tomb.
