

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Third Sunday of Easter

Acts: 3:13-15, 17-19 Chapter three of Acts describes how Peter and John healed a lame man who sat begging each day at the gate of the temple. The people were astonished at his miracle. Peter used the opportunity to give a sermon encouraging the people to believe in Jesus. We hear a portion of this sermon in today's passage.

1 John 2:1-5 The first letter of John was written for the community from which the fourth gospel emerged. At the time, this community was seriously divided. Some members believed that as long as you had faith in Jesus, it didn't matter what you did in daily life. The passage today refutes that opinion.

ST. JOHN PAUL II AND THE CHURCH'S DEVOTION TO ST. JOSEPH

"After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. And all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers. When his parents saw him they were astonished; and his mother said to him, "Child why have you treated us like this? Look, your father and I have been searching for you in great anxiety. Then he went down with them to Nazareth, and was obedient to them." (Lk 2:46-49)


