INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Jeremiah 38: 4-6, 8-10 In 597 B.C., Babylon (located in modern day Iraq) defeated Jerusalem, and thousands of Jewish leaders and citizens were taken into exile. The prophet Jeremiah was among those left behind. When he preached trust in God rather than armed revolution, the people considered him a traitor.

Hebrews 12: 1-4 Commonly referred to as a letter, Hebrews is really a lengthy sermon that encourages people to remain faithful in difficult times. In the previous section of the book, the author cited Old Testament witnesses who had done just that. In this week's reading, the author now points out the greatest example of fidelity




