

Classes will begin on Sunday, September 15 at 10:00 AM.

Registration for students in grades pre-k thru grade 11 will take place the weekend after Labor day, Sept. 7-8 in the Activity Building after all Masses. (Registration forms are available in the Church entrance and on the parish

website, if you'd like to fill it out in advance.)

This year's fee is \$20 per student. The fee helps with some of the cost for the books and supplies. All students must register, even if in the program last year. Catholic school students in 2nd and 9 - 11 grades must also register to be enrolled in the First Communion and the Confirmation programs.
